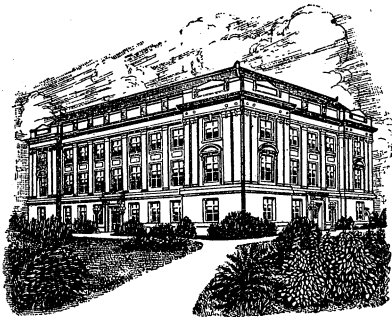

The County Board granting the petition presented by the Tax-payers of the Town of Sanborn, which petitioned for a change in the boundries of the Towns of Sanborn and Gingles.


The changes made are as follows:

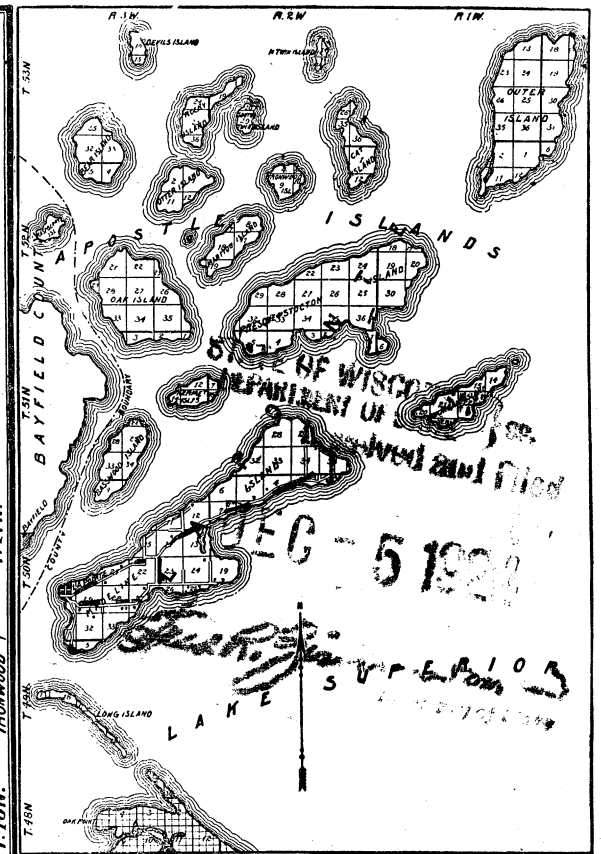
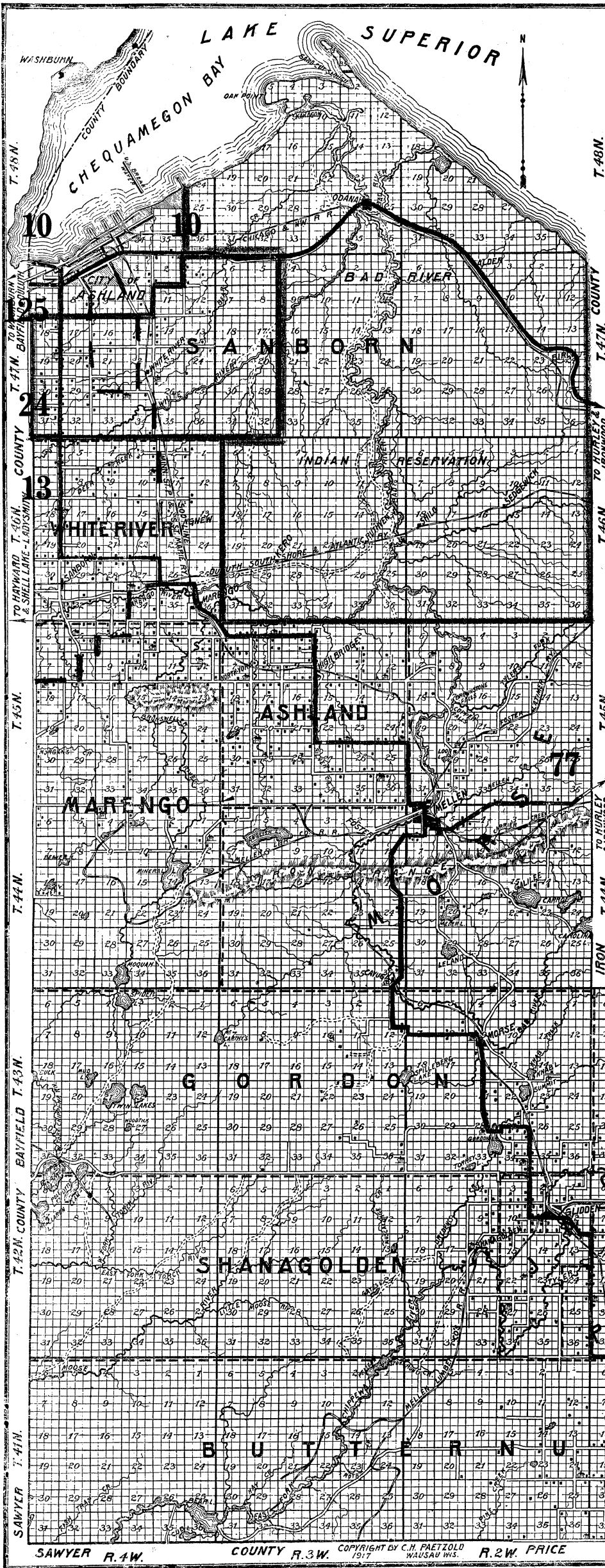
Fractional Section Twenty Four (24), and all of Sections Twenty Five (25) and Thirty Six (36), in Township Forty Eight (48) North, Range Four (4) West; Fractional Section Nineteen (19), and all of Sections Thirty (30) and Thirty One (31), Township Forty Eight (48) North, Range Three (3) West, were detached from the Town of Gingles and attached to the Town of Sanborn.

Sections Five (5), Eight (8), Seventeen (17), Twenty (20), Twenty Nine (29) and Thirty Two (32), Township Forty Seven (47) North, Range Three (3) West, were detached from the Town of Sanborn and attached to the Town of Gingles.

The accompanying map will show you the present boundry lines of the Town of Gingles drawn in Blue Pencil, and the present boundry lines of the Town of Sanborn drawn in Red Pencil.
