Hon. D. W. Jones Dear Sir

At a special meeting of the County Board of Supervisors held in and for the County of Buffalo Wisconsin May the 25th 1858 it was ordered and determined that the boundaries of the town of Buffalo be changed as follows to wit: That all of sections 4. 5. 6. 7. 8. 9 and 10 in Township 19 Range 10 West lying in the County of Buffalo be set off and taken from the town of Buffalo and added to the town of Oriskany.

It was also ordered that the name of the town of Mottom be changed and known and called as the town of Eagle Mills.

It was further ordered that the ^{name of} ~~town~~ the town of Elk Creek be changed and known as the town of Gilmanston.
