STATE OF WISCONSIN, DOUGLAS COUNTY. IN CIRCUIT COURT

In the Matter of the petition for
Organizing the ~~town of Summit~~ *the New Town of Summit*

The petition in this matter having been duly brought on to hearing and been heard, and the Court, having jurisdiction of the matter, having made and filed its findings of facts, wherein it finds that the territory sought to be created into said new Town of Summit is now part of the Towns of Gordon and Superior, in said Douglas County, and is described as follows, to wit: that part which is now a part of the Town of Gordon aforesaid is, Township 43 north, Range 14 west, Township 43 north, Range 15 west, Township 44 north, Range 14 west, Township 44 north, Range 15 west, Township 45 north, Range 14 west, Township 45 north, Range 15 west, and that part which is now a part of the Town of Superior aforesaid is Township 46 north, Range 14 west, Township 46 north, Range 15 west, and Sections number 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, and 36, of Township 47 north, Range 15 west, all according to the United States Government survey, all of said territory being in Douglas County, Wisconsin: that the said petition contains the names of all the resident electors within said territory proposed to be organized into said new Town and that there are seventy of such resident electors; that there are fifty-three and no more resident freeholders and homesteaders in said territory and that they are all included in the list of resident electors contained in said petition; that the petition is signed by sixty-four resident electors within said territory and that the ~~sixty-four~~ said sixty-four resident electors who have signed said petition includes all the resident freeholders and homesteaders who reside within said territory except three; that the assessed valuation of the entire Town of Gordon according to the last preceding assessment is \$327,085 and that the assessed valuation of the entire Town of Superior aforesaid according to the last preceding assessment is \$984,938; that the assessed valuation of the territory aforesaid which is now a part of the Town of Gordon and which is included within the proposed new Town of Summit according to the last

preceding assessment is \$217,495, and that the assessed valuation of the territory aforesaid which is now a part of said Town of Superior and which is included within the proposed new town of Summit according to the last preceding assessment is the sum of \$397,136; that the said Town of ~~##~~ Gordon has no indebtedness against it, and that the said Town of Gordon owns property, to wit, a Town Hall, ~~and a road grader~~ a road grader and road tools, the total value of which is \$1800; that the said Town of Superior has Town property, assets or credits to the extent or value of \$98,303.42, and that said Town of Superior has obligations or indebtedness to the extent and amount of \$118,303.42. That is to say that the said Town of Superior has legally incurred indebtedness in excess of its assets and credits to the extent and amount of \$20,000; that this indebtedness draws interest at the rate of 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ % per annum, payable annually, and that the principal of said indebtedness falls due in twelve equal installments, one of which falls due in each of the next succeeding twelve years, and ~~###~~ that $\frac{1}{12}$ of said amount, plus interest on the unpaid balance, at said rate will fall due and become payable each succeeding year until the whole shall be paid; that the remaining territory in the said ^{Existing} Town of Gordon is in excess of a Government Township and that the remaining territory in the said existing Town of Superior is more than a Government Township; that the Nelson school house, located on the South-east corner of Section numbered 30 in Township 46 north, Range 15 west, in the said proposed new town of Summit is a convenient and reasonable place for holding the first Town meeting; that all the facts set forth in said petition are true and that all the requirements of Chapter 21 of the Laws of Wisconsin for 1905 have been complied with.

And the Court having found as conclusion of law, that an order be entered creating the aforesaid territory into a new Town, naming it Summit, providing for the place of holding the first annual meeting and apportioning the indebtedness of said Town of Superior between the remaining or existing Town of Superior and the said new Town of Summit, and also apportioning the credits of the said Town of Gordon ^{between the remaining or existing Town of Gordon} and the said new town of Summit.

Now on motion of H.V. Gard, as attorney for the petitioners,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

First. That the territory hereinbefore and hereinafter described be, and it hereby is, created into a new Town, to-wit: Township forty-three (43) north, Range fourteen (14) west, Township forty-three (43) north, Range fifteen (15) west, Township forty-four (44) north, Range fourteen (14) west, Township forty-four (44) north, Range fifteen (15) west, Township forty-five (45) north, Range fourteen (14) west, Township forty-five (45) north, Range fifteen (15) west, Township forty-six (46) north, Range fourteen (14) west, Township forty-six (46) north, Range fifteen (15) west, and Sections twenty-five (25), twenty-six (26), ~~twenty-seven~~ twenty-seven (27), twenty-eight (28), twenty-nine (29), thirty (30), thirty-one (31), thirty-two (32), thirty-three (33), thirty-four (34), thirty-five (35), and thirty-six (36) of Township forty-seven (47) north, Range fifteen (15) west, all according to the United States Government survey, all being in Douglas County, Wisconsin.

Second. That said new Town be, and it hereby is, named Summit.

Third. That the place of holding the first annual town meeting shall be ~~at~~ the Nelson School House on the southeast corner of Section numbered 30 in Township 46 north, Range 15 west, in said Town of Summit.

Fourth. That the portion of said indebtedness of the said Town of *Superior* chargeable to that part of the said new Town of Summit so detached from said Town of Superior is the sum of eight thousand sixty-four dollars and twenty cents (\$8064.20), and that one twelfth (1/12) of said amount plus interest on the unpaid balance at the rate of three and one half percent (3½%) per annum shall become payable and be paid by said Town of Summit to said Town of Superior annually until the whole of said \$8064.20 and interest shall be paid, and that said annual installments shall be annually assessed on the tax roll against the taxable property of said territory of the Town of Summit which was detached from said Town of Superior, and shall be annually paid to said Town of Superior.

Fifth. That the just share of assets or credits of the said Town of Gordon, now due that part of said Town of Summit which was formerly a part of said Town of Gordon, and which is chargeable to, and due from

said Town of Gordon to said Town of Summit is the sum of seven hundred forty-two dollars and seventy cents (\$742.70) which sum shall be assessed on the next tax roll of the Town of Gordon and shall be paid to the said Town of Summit.
