

The Board of Supervisors, of the County of  
Dunn, State of Wisconsin at their meeting  
held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of March 1859. did  
order and determine as follows - That  
that part of Town Twenty Six (26) Range  
Twelve (12) lying South and East of the  
Chippewa River be taken from the Town  
of Rock Creek, and a new Town or-  
ganized therefrom, to be known as the  
Town of Peru and that the first Town  
meeting thereof be held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day  
of April 1859, at Locke's School House  
in said Territory,

The Boundaries of the said Town of Peru  
is as follows, to wit, Commencing at the  
South East corner of Township Twenty  
Six (26), North Range Twelve West thence  
running north on the township line  
to the Chippewa River, thence running  
South Westward following the channel of  
said river to the township line between  
ranges Twelve (12) and Thirteen (13) West  
thence south on said line to the the  
South West corner of Township Twenty

(26) North Range Twelve (12) West. Thence east on the Township line between Townships No. Twenty five (25) and Twenty Six (26) to the place of beginning.

The following are the boundaries of the Town of Rock ~~Creek~~ <sup>at</sup> as it remained since taking the above specified town therefrom to wit - commencing at the South East corner of Township No. Twenty Six (26) Range Eleven (11) West. Thence running north on the Township line between Ranges Ten (10) and Eleven (11) to the Chipperose river, thence running West by following the channel of said stream to the Township line between Ranges Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) thence south of said line to the South West corner of Township No. Twenty Six (26) Range Eleven (11) West. Thence east on the line between Township No. Twenty five (25) and Twenty Six (26) North to the place of beginning.
