ORDINANCE FOR DIVISION OF TOWN OF LUDINGTON, ETC.

The County Board of Supervisors of Eau Claire County do ordain and determine, upon the petition and vote, pursuant to law, of freeholders, residents and legal voters of the Town of Ludington, Eau Claire County, Wisconsin, that from and after April 1st, A. D., 1916, the eastern boundry line of the said Town of Ludington be changed from the easterly line of said County to the line running along the westerly side of Section Two, Eleven, Fourteen, Twenty-three, Twenty-six and Thirty-five, in Township 27 North, Range 6 West, that all the portion of said Town of Ludington easterly from said last mentioned line be and is set off from and after April 1st., A. D., 1916 and organized as a separate town to be known as "The Town of Wilson" bounded on the north by the northerly line of Eau Claire County, on the east by the easterly line of said County, on the south by the southerly line of Township 27 North, and on the west by the line running along the westerly side of Sections 2, 11, 14, 23, 26 and 35, in Township 27 North, Range 6 West, and that the first town meeting of said Town of Wilson be held at the Charles Eckler school-house in said town, April 4th, 1916 at 9 A. M. That the County Clerk make a record and plat in compliance with Section 673, and immediately cause this ordinance to be published pursuant to Section 674, and that a joint session of the Boards of the Town of Ludington and of the Town of Wilson to determine what portion of the indebtedness legally incurred by the old Town at the time when such division goes into effect shall be chargeable to the respective portions so detached to form such new Town, pursuant to Section 672 of the Statutes, and for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before said Joint Session, shall be held beginning at 9:00 o'clock A. M, April 15th, A. D., 1916, at the school-house of District Number One, in said Town of Ludington.

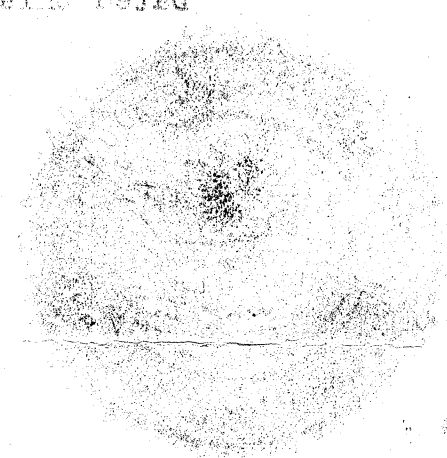
