AN ORDINANCE to vacate and abolish the town of Ridgeway, in the county of Iowa, Wisconsin, and to organize the territory heretofore contained therein, into two new towns.

The County Board of Supervisors of the said county of Iowa do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the town of Ridgeway, in the county of Iowa and state of Wisconsin be, and it hereby is, vacated and abolished.

Section 2. That the following territory heretofore included in the said old town, to-wit:—sections one, two, three, four, nine, ten, eleven and twelve of, town five (5) range four (4), sections one, two, three, four, nine, ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, twenty-one, twenty-two, twenty-three, twenty-four, twenty-five, twenty-six, twenty-seven, twenty-eight, thirty-three, thirty-four, thirty-five and thirty-six, of town six (6), range four (4); and sections twenty-one, twenty-two, twenty-three, twenty-four, twenty-five, twenty-six, twenty-seven, twenty-eight, thirty-three, thirty-four, thirty-five and thirty-six, of town seven (7) range four (4) east of the fourth principal meridian, be, and the said territory hereby is, organized into a new town, by and under, the name of the town of Ridgeway.

Section 3. That the remainder of the territory heretofore contained in the said old town, to wit: Sections one to twelve inclusive, of town five (5) of range five (5), all of town six (6) range five (5), and sections nineteen to thirty-six inclusive, of town seven (7) of said range five (5) east of the said meridian, be, and it hereby is, organized into a new town by and under, the name of the town of Brigham.

Section 4. That the first town meeting in the said new town of Ridgeway, shall be held on the Tuesday of April 1890, at the school house in the village of Ridgeway, in said town.

Section 5. That the first town meeting in the said town of Brigham, shall be held on the first Tuesday of April 1890, at the Jones Valley school house, situated on section twenty two (22), town six (6) range five (5) in said last named town.

Section 6. That the town records of the said old town of Ridgeway are to be kept and preserved, in the town clerk's office of the said new town of Ridgeway.

Section 7. That the indebtedness of the said old town of Ridgeway shall be paid by the said new towns of Ridgeway and Brigham, pro rata, according to the last assessment roll of the said old town, to wit:—the said new town of Ridgeway shall pay the three-eighths part thereof, and the said town of Brigham shall pay the remaining five-eighths part, thereof.

Section 8. That all property of the said old town, and all money in the treasury of the said old town, belonging to the general fund at the time this ordinance shall take effect, shall be divided between the said new towns of Ridgeway and Brigham, in the same proportion as provided in section seven, for the payment of the indebtedness of the said old town of Ridgeway.

Section 9. That this ordinance shall be published in the Dodgeville Chronicle, March 14th, 1890, and shall take effect and be in force from and after twelve days after its passage and publication.
