Ordered that the Town of Buffalo be divided and set apart and organized into Townships in the following manner

That Township No 14 Range 10 shall constitute one town & be known by the name of Buffalo ---

That Township No 14 Range 8 & Township 14. Range 9 shall constitute one town to be known by the name of Moundville - - - - -

That Township No 15 Range 8 & Township No 15 Range 9 & all north of said town (in the County of Marquette) shall constitute one town to be known by the name of Packwaukee ----

That Township No 18th north of range 10 and all north of said town (in the County of Marquette) shall constitute one town to be known by the name of Montello. Excepting that so much and all that portion of Township 14. Range 10 lying East of the West branch of Grand River be & then is set off & attached to the town of Marquette and shall hereafter constitute & be a part of said town of Marquette
