An ordinance to create the town of Woodruff.

The County Board of Supervisors of Oneida County do ordain as follows:

First, Township Number Thirty Nine (39) north of Range seven east and Sections number One, Two, Three and Four of Township Number Thirt Nine North of Range Six (6) East in Oneida County, are hereby detached from the town of Minocqua and created into a new town to be known as the town of Woodruff.

Second, It is hereby determined that the territory so created into the new town contains a population of more than One Hundred Twenty Five inhabitants more than twenty five of whom have been actual electors of this State and residents within the said territory so created into the town of Woodruff for at least six months last past.

Third, The valuation of the territory so set off and created into the town of Woodruff is \$44,192. and the value of the territory in the town of Minocqua before the said territory is detached is \$388,167. all according to the last tax roll.

Fourth, It is hereby determined that the new town of Woodruff is liable for Eleven and six tenths percent of the indebtedness of the town of Minocqua and is entitled to receive of the said town eleven and six tenths percent of its assets. It is further determined that the assets and liabilities of the said town of Minocqua are equal, provided that the said town of Woodruff pays the assessors and assistants salary who has made the assessment of the territory embraced in the new town, and it is determined that said new town shall pay such salary.

The town of Woodruff shall further pay a \$75.00 lumber bill to Ross Lumber Co.

And it is provided furthe that the territory of the new town shall not be liable for taxes levied in the town of Minocqua but is set off free from such taxes. The town of Minocqua shall pay all state indebtedness due from such town and the new town shall not be liable for any part of such indebtedness.

Fifth. The first town meeting of the town of Woodruff shall be held in the town hall in the village of Woodruff, July fifth 1905.

Sixth. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its passage and publication.
