ASSISTANT SECY OF STATE.

Ordinance.

To the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Oneida, do
ORDAIN as follows;

There is hereby detached from the town of Pelican in said County
of Oneida the following Territory, and the same is attached to, and made
a part of the town of Monico, To Wit:

Sections One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Ten (10), Eleven (11), Twelve (12),
Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14), Fifteen (15), Twenty two (22), Twenty three
(23), Twenty four (24), Twenty five (25), Twenty six (26), Twenty seven
(27), Thirty four (34), Thirty five (35) and Thirty six (36), all in town-
ship Thirty six (36), north of Range Ten (10), East.

II.

That the town of Monico shall pay to the town of Pelican the
Just proportion of the indebtedness, and shall receive the just proportion
of the credits, of the town of Pelican: The same to be ascertained and
divided pro rata according to the Assessment Roll of said town for the
year 1908.

It is further understood and agreed that the town of Monico is to
pay to the town of Pelican in the year 1910, the sum of Five hundred and
forty dollars(\$540.00), and that the town of Minico does not claim any
credit from Pelican,

III,

This ordinance shall take effect, and be in force from and after
its passage and publication.
