Dover, March 28th 1855.

- The Board of Supervisors of the County of Portage do Order and direct mine as follows:
- Sec. 1st Township Number Twenty Three (23) in Range Number Nine (9) in the County of Portage is hereby taken off of the Town of Dover and shall hereafter for the purpose of Town Government be known and constitute the Town of Stockton
- Sec. 2^d Said Town shall organize and hold its first meeting on the last Monday in May A.D. 1855.
- Sec. 3^d The place for holding the first Town meeting in said Town shall be the House of John Shannon in said Town.

March 29th 1855

- The Board of Supervisors of the County of Portage do Order and determine as follows:
- Sec. 1st That all that portion of Portage County composed of Townships Twenty one (21) Twenty two (22) Twenty three (23) Twenty four (24) and Twenty five (25) of Ranges Two (2) and three (3) and Townships Twenty two (22) Twenty three (23) Twenty four (24) and Twenty five (25) of Range four (4) heretofore known under the name of Town of Eagle Point, shall be and the same is hereby vacated for the purposes of Town Government.
- Sec. 2^d And that said Portion of Portage County be and the same hereby is annexed and shall be for the purpose of Town Government be a part of the Town of Grand Rapids.
