I Augustus P. Noyes Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of Waukegan County hereby certify that the following are the boundaries names and boundaries of new towns organized by the Board of Supervisors at their last Annual Meeting.

That Township Nineteen North, Range Eleven East into one town by the Name of Mount Morris the first Town Meeting to be held at the house of Ezekiel Hawley on the first Tuesday of April next, 1853.

That Township Nineteen North, Range Twelve East, and Township Nineteen North, Range Thirteen East into one town by the Name of Pine-River, and the first Town Meeting held at the house of Matthias Seave on the first Tuesday of April next 1853

"The Board of Supervisors of the County of Waukegan do order and determine as follows.

Section 1st "That the Name of the town of Norwich in the County of Waukegan be and is hereby changed to that of "Oasis"
