ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

The Village Board of the Village of Amherst, County of Portage, State of Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1 Annexed Territory</u>. The territory subject to this ordinance, located in the Town of AMherst, Portage County, Wisconsin, is described as follows:

That part of Lot No. 1 of Portage County Certified Survey Map No. 3755, as recorded in Volume 13, Page 113 of Certified Surveys lying in the N.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 21, Town 23 North, Range 10 East, Town of Amherst, County of Portage, State of Wisconsin, including those lands lying between the lot lines extended to the Easterly Right-of-Way EOF line of School Road.

line of School Road. Section 2 Prerequisites to Annexation: The following prerequisites to annexation of the territory have been met and SEP 30 1987 complied with:

(a) A Petition for Direct Annexation of the territopy TARY OF STATE dated July 6, 1987 and amended September 15, 1987, was duly filed with the Village on September 16, 1987.

(b) The Petitioner, Amherst Area Foundation, by Barbara Konkol, President, Paul Kliegl, Vice President, Michael Juris, Secretary and LaVerne Peterson, Treasurer, is the sole owner of all interests in the territory, and no electors or other persons reside in the territory.

(c) The territory is contiguous to the Village of Amherst.

(d) A copy of the Petition and accompanying scale map of the proposed annexation was duly sent to the Clerk of the Town of Amherst and the Department of Development.

(e) Notice was provided the Department of Development, and the Department of Development has advised that the proposed annexation has been favorably reviewed and not found to be against the public interest.

(f) The Village of Amherst Plan Commission has recommended annexation.

<u>Section 3 Annexation</u>: Effective immediately the territory described in Section 1 is a part of and incorporated in the Village of Amherst, County of Portage, State of Wisconsin, for all purposes. All persons now or hereafter coming upon or residing within the territory are subject to all laws, ordinances, rules, and regulations of the Village of Amherst. Section 4 Administrative Requirements: The Village Clerk shall immediately file a certified copy of the ordinance, certificate and plat to each of the following:

(a) Secretary of State

(b) Each company that provides any utility service to the territory.

(c) Clerk of the Town of Amherst

(d) Register of Deeds for Portage County

(e) Tomorrow River School District.

Section 5 Zoning of Annexed Lands: All lands annexed by this ordinance shall be assigned final zoning of "R-2" Residential Single Family.

<u>Section 6 Severability</u>: In the event any provision or part of this ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional, or if application of this ordinance to any particular person is held invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions for applications of this ordinance, which for all other purposes shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7 Effective Date: This ordinance shall take effect upon enactment, as provided by law.
