The above ~~entitled~~ ^{matter} action having been brought to a hearing at the above mentioned term of Court and it appearing that due notice of the time and place of making said application has been given as required by law, that said applicants have caused to be made by a practical surveyor an accurate survey and map of the territory intended to be embraced within the limits of said village showing the courses and distances of the boundaries and the quantity of land embraced therein, the accuracy of which was verified by the affidavit of the surveyor annexed thereto and that said applicants have caused to be taken ^{also} an accurate census of the resident population of such territory on such day or days not ten weeks prior to the hearing of this application, which census exhibits the name of every head of a family and the name of every person, a resident in good faith of such territory on the days such census was taken, and the lot or quarter section of land on which he resided which census was verified by the affidavit of the person taking the same affixed thereto: that such survey, map and census verified as aforesaid were left on the 8th day of August A.D.1901 at the office of August Homstead, a resident of said territory, his office being the Post Office, in said proposed village and located on the North West Quarter(1/4) of

Section thirteen in township twenty nine (29) in range one east and located on the main business street of said proposed village, and was there kept subject to examination at all reasonable hours by every person interested for a period of six weeks from the date of the publication of the notice in the "Reporter" which is herein after mentioned.

That said application on the 8th day of August A.D. 1901 gave due and proper notice that on the 28th day of September at ten O'clock in the forenoon of said day at the City of Neillsville, Wisconsin ~~for as soon thereafter as the matter could be heard~~ the would apply to the said Circuit Court for an Order incorporating the territory, the territory herein after mentioned as a village by the name of Dorchester, which said notice described the boundaries of said territory by courses and distances and specified the Town within which it was situated and also stated where such survey, map and census had been left and might be examined, that said notice was signed and authorized by at least eleven tax payers, residents of the said territory proposed to be incorporated, was printed once each week for six successive weeks in "The Reporter" a weekly news-paper printed in said proposed territory, before the time specified said notice for making this application to wit: The first publication was made the 8th day of August, A.D. 1901 that the persons authorizing the said notice are the same ones making this application and the said applicants having by petition subscribed by them which sets forth the boundaries, with their courses and distances the quantity of land embraced therein according to such survey and the resident population therein contained according to such census: applied to the Court for an order incorporating such village

And such survey, map and census with affidavits verifying the same and an affidavit that they were left and kept subject to examination at the office of August Homstead as hereinbefore set forth and also a copy of the notice of this application with an affidavit affixed thereto of the printing of this notice as hereinbefore set forth being annexed to said application and the same being presented to the Court at the time and place specified in said notice for presenting the same.

And after hearing all parties interested for and against said application and being satisfied that all of the requirements of the Statutes have been complied with, that the territory proposed to be incorporated is not less than one half mile square

ated is not less than one half square mile in area-- , is all in the town of Mayville, Clark County Wisconsin and contains a resident population of not less than *Four Hundred seventy one* persons therein, that the said lands ought justly be included in such village, and that the interests of the inhabitants will be promoted by such incorporation:

It is therefore Ordered: That the following territory viz;

Commencing at the center of Section twelve (12) in township Twenty nine (29) North of Range one(1) East Thence South on a magnetic variation of 5 40' E, 39.97 chains to the center of Section Thirteen (13) thence West on a magnetic variation of 6^o 27' E, 39.33 chains to the quarter post between sections Thirteen(13) and Fourteen (14) thence West on a magnetic variation of 6^o 10' E, 40.05 chains to the center of Section fourteen (14) thence North on a magnetic variation of 5^o 40' E, 40 chains to the quarter post between Sections Eleven(11) and fourteen (14) thence North on a magnetic variation of 5^o E. 39.80 chains to the center of section eleven(11) thence East on a magnetic variation of 5^o 30' East 39.67 chains to the q quarter post betwwwe sections eleven (11) and twelve (12) , thence East on a magnetic variation of 6^o 52' East 39.95 chains to the place of beeginning .

Embracing within said limits the South West quarter (1/4) of Section twelve (12) . The north West quarter of Section thirteen (13) , the North East quarter (1/4) of Section fourteen (14) and the South East quarter of Section eleven (11), All in Township Twenty Nine (29), North of Range one (1) East, being in the Town of Mayville, Clark County Wisconsin; shall be an incorporated Village by the name of Dorchester if the electors thereof shall assent thereto as provided by section 862 of t the Wisconsin Statutes of 1898.

That an election be held therein in the manner provided by law , and that Ray W.Hugoboom, Frank Nagel and August Homstead residents of said territory are hereby appointed to perform the duties of inspectors of election as required by Chapter Forty of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1898
