On the application by petition of W.S.
John Martin Henderson, B. Skene, F. L.
Johnson and T. Thompson for an order
that certain territory therein described be
incorporated as a village, the said
petitioners having appeared by Myron
Reed their attorney, and there being
no appearance by any resident and
taxpayer against such application;
After hearing the allegations and proofs
and considering the same the
Court being satisfied;

First That the survey and the Census
annexed to such petition are correct.

Second That all the requirements of
the Statutes have been complied with
^{by such petitioners}

Third That such territory contained
at the time such census was taken
the population in number and pro-
portion to the quantity of land
therein required in Section 85 ^{of the} Revised
Statutes.

Therefore it is ordered that such
territory bounded and described as
follows to wit; Commencing at the North
East Corner of Section Twenty four town-
~~ship~~ forty seven North Range Eleven West
according to government survey running
thence South on Section line to South East
Corner of said Section; thence East on Section
line to North East Corner of Section Thirty
Township forty seven North Range Ten
West; thence South on Section line to
South East Corner of Section Thirty one,
Township forty seven North Range
ten West; thence West on Section line
to North West Corner of Section Six
Township forty six North Range ten West;
thence South on Section line to South
East Corner of Section Twelve Township
forty six North Range Eleven West;
thence West on Section line to South
West Corner of Section Eleven Township
forty six North Range Eleven West;
thence North on Section line to
South East Corner of Section three
Township forty six North Range
Eleven West; thence West on Section

line to South west corner of said
Section three; thence North on Section
line to North West corner of said
Section three; thence East on the
Section line to the ~~quarter~~ line of
Section thirty four ~~thence~~
~~thence~~ forty seven North Range
Eleven West; thence North on
quarter line to North Section line of
Section twenty two ~~thence~~
forty seven North Range Eleven
West; thence East on Section line
to place of beginning, course and dis-
tances being according to government
survey and as shown on the map
accompanying said petition, -

E A Every Hal J Hume and
James Wright being each duly sworn on
oath says each for himself that he
served as inspector of a Special Election
held in the proposed village of Lake
Neboquanon in said County January the
8th 1907 to determine whether said village
should be incorporated as provided
in an order of the Circuit Court of
said County dated November 30th 1906
That Max Bailey appointed in said
order as one of said inspectors
not being present and unable to attend
said Election the appellant James Wright
was appointed in his place according
to statute in such case made & provided
That we each acted as inspectors of
said Election and took the oath
hereto appended. That said Election
was conducted without fraud deceit
or abuse as we each believe.
That the whole number of votes cast
at said Election was One Hundred
Twenty five (125) of which number

Written ballots were "No" and one
Hundred Seventy Six (176) were "Yes"
That notice of said Election was
duly given and published in the
Hobokenian Enterprise a weekly paper
published in said proposed village
for three successive weeks as will
more fully appear in the proof of
publication attached to this affi-
davit; That the statement hereto
attached of said Election and
signed by each of us is a true and
correct statement of the result of
said Election. One copy of the full
list of said Election is hereto
attached
