



AN ORDINANCE DETACHING CERTAIN PROPERTY FROM  
THE TOWN OF HUSTISFORD, DODGE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, **ROBERT C. ZIMMERMAN**  
AND ANNEXING IT TO THE VILLAGE OF HUSTISFORD, **SECRETARY OF STATE**  
DODGE COUNTY, WISCONSIN.

The Village Board of the Village of Hustisford do ordain as follows:

That the following described territory situated in the county of Dodge and state of Wisconsin, and which is contiguous to the Village of Hustisford, for which direct annexation has been petitioned by the owners of all of the real property in said territory, be and hereby is detached from the Town of Hustisford, Dodge County, Wisconsin, and annexed to the Village of Hustisford, Dodge County, Wisconsin:

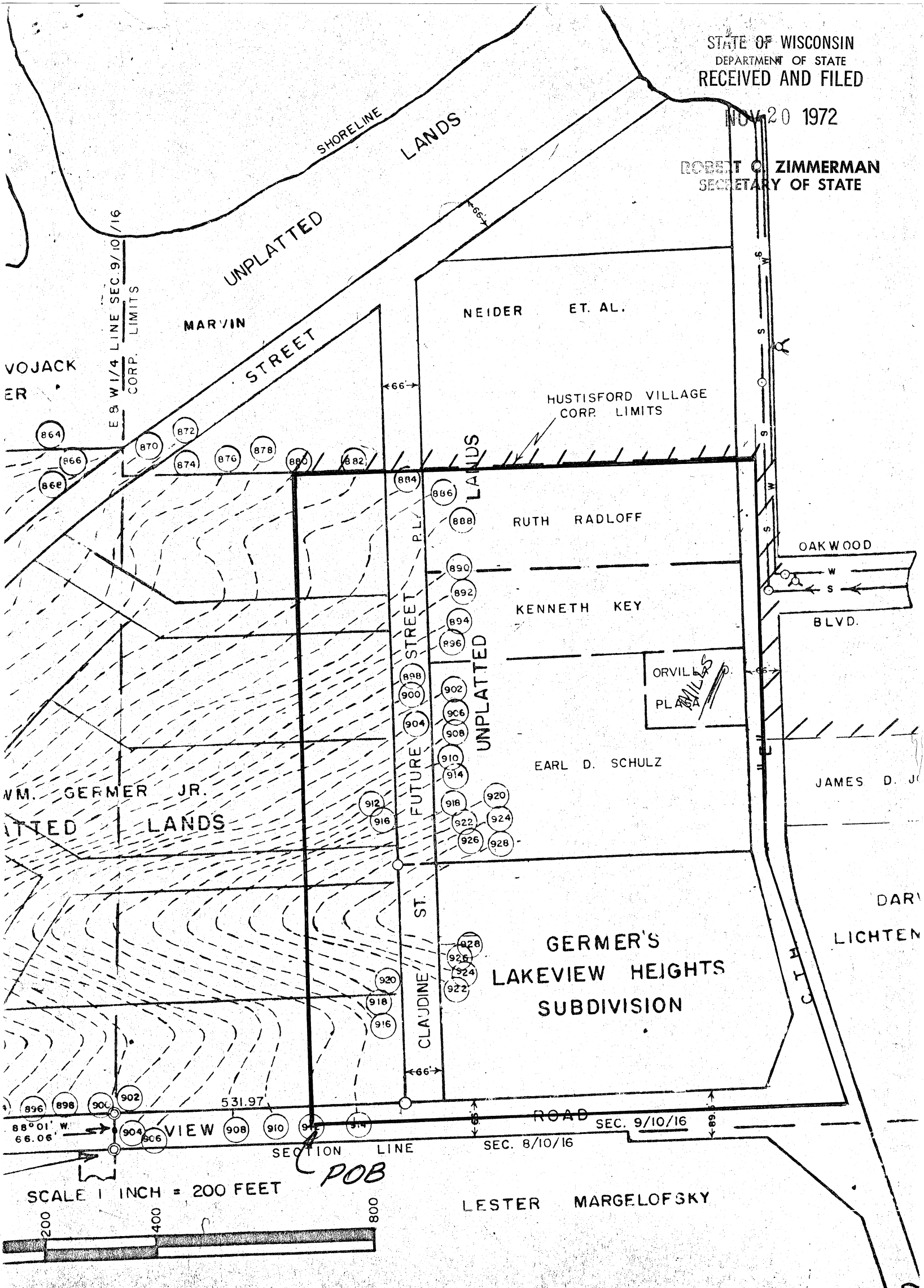
