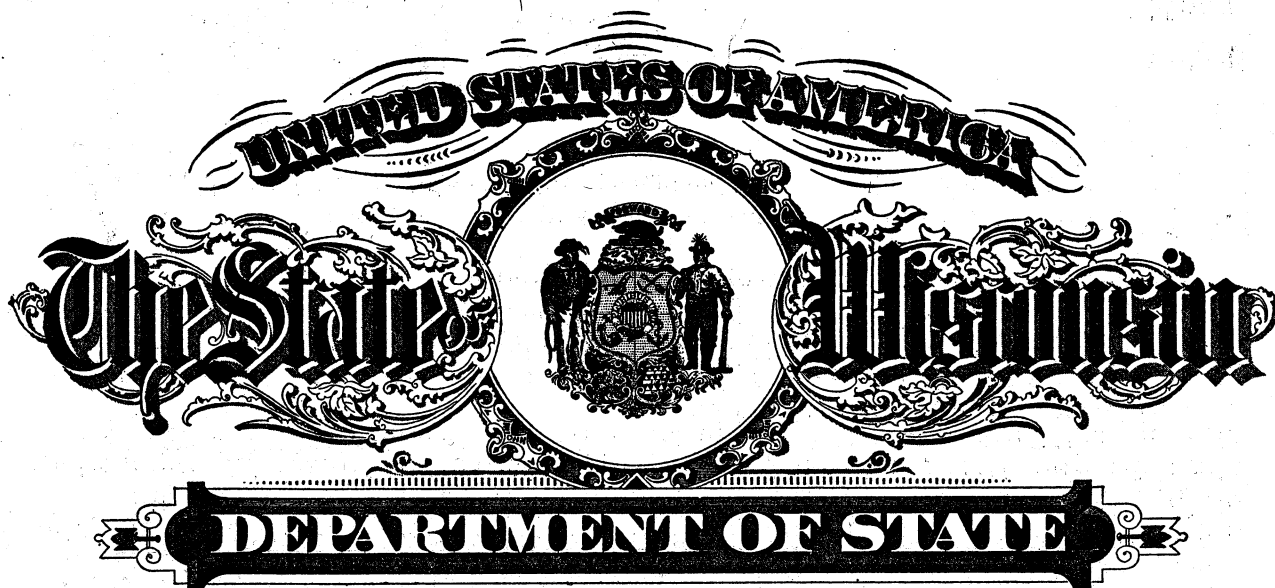

## CHAPTER 179.

AN ACT to repeal subsections (1) and (2) of section 61.59 of the statutes, and to recreate subsections (1) and (2) of said section relating to special village charters.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Subsections (1) and (2) of section 61.59 of the statutes are repealed.

SECTION 2. Two new subsections are added to the statutes to read:

61.59 (1) On and after January 1, 1928, all villages now operating under special charter are hereby reincorporated under and shall be governed by the provisions of this chapter. All such special charters are hereby repealed as of said date. The secretary of state shall issue to any such village, upon application of the clerk, a certificate of incorporation under general law. Such application shall contain a certified description of the legal boundaries of the village as of the date of said application.

(2) The incumbents of the several village offices at the time of such reincorporation shall continue in the office and shall discharge the duties thereof until the various officers, provided for by the new charter, shall have been elected and qualified.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 180.

AN ACT to amend subsection (7) of section 136.01 of the statutes, relating to the real estate brokers board.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Subsection (7) of section 136.01 of the statutes is amended to read: (136.01) (7) The board, immediately following the qualification of the member appointed in each year, shall organize by *appointing a secretary and by selecting from*

Name of Village: Sauk City,

Name of County: Sauk.

Legal boundaries: Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Southwest quarter (S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest quarter (S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Number One (1), Township Number Nine (9), North of Range Number Six (6), East, running thence South 99.92 chains to the Southwest corner of Section Number Twelve (12), in said Township and Range, thence East twenty (20) chains to the Southeast corner of the Southwest quarter (S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest quarter (S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section Number Twelve (12), being also the Northwest corner of Fraction Number Four (4), in Section Number Thirteen (13), in said Township and Range, thence South twenty-nine (29) chains to the right bank of the Wisconsin River, thence Southeasterly at right angles with the center line of the Westerly or present main channel of the Wisconsin River to said center line, thence Northeasterly up the river along said center line to the South section line in said Section Number Twelve (12), thence East to the center line of the Easterly or old main channel of the Wisconsin River, which line is the County line between the counties of Sauk and Dane, thence Northeasterly up the river along said line to the South one-eighth (S.  $\frac{1}{8}$ ) line of Section Number One (1), in Township Number Nine (9), North of Range Number Six (6), East, thence West to the place of beginning, all said territory hereafter contained in said village of Sauk City and included within its new boundaries is situated in the County of Sauk and State of Wisconsin.

I do hereby certify that the foregoing description of boundaries of the Village of Sauk City is correct and true to the best of my knowledge and belief.

Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Southwest quarter (S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest quarter (S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Number One (1), Township Number Nine (9), North of Range Number Six (6), East, running thence South 99.92 chains to the Southwest corner of Section Number Twelve (12), in said Township and Range, thence East twenty (20) chains to the Southeast corner of the Southwest quarter (S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest quarter (S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section Number Twelve (12), being also the Northwest corner of Fraction Number Four (4), in Section Number Thirteen (13), in said Township and Range, thence South twenty-nine (29) chains to the right bank of the Wisconsin River, thence Southeasterly at right angles with the center line of the Westerly or present main channel of the Wisconsin River to said center line, thence Northeasterly up the river along said center line to the South section line in said Section Number Twelve (12), thence East to the center line of the Easterly or old main channel of the Wisconsin River, which line is the County line between the counties of Sauk and Dane, thence Northeasterly up the river along said line to the South one-eighth (S.1/8) line of Section Number One (1), in Township Number Nine (9), North of Range Number Six (6), East, thence West to the place of beginning.
