AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF LOHRVILLE,
WISCONSIN

The Village Board of the Village of Lohrville, Wisconsin,
do ordain as follows;

SECTION 1. Direct Annexation- In accordance with s.66.021 (12)
of the Wisconsin statutes of 1967, and the petition for direct
annexation filed with the Village Clerk on the 6th day of March,
1976, signed by the owners of the land and real property in the
territory, the following described territory in the Town of
Warren, Waushara County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the Village
of Lohrville, Wisconsin;

Commencing at the Southwest corner of the Southeast
quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Seven (7), Township Eighteen (18)
North, Range Twelve (12) East, thence North five hundred
twenty eight (528) feet to a point in the highway; thence
West four hundred ninety five (495) feet to an iron stake;
thence South five hundred twenty eight (528) feet to an iron
stake on the South section line; thence east on the section
line four hundred ninety five (495) feet to the place of
beginning, containing six (6) acres more or less.

SECTION 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of
this ordinance the territory described in Section 1 shall be
a part of the Village of Lohrville for and all purposes by
law and all persons coming or residing within such territory
shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations
governing the Village of Lohrville.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is
invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this
ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconsti-
tutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not effect
the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which
can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional
provision or application.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect
upon passage and publication as provided by law.

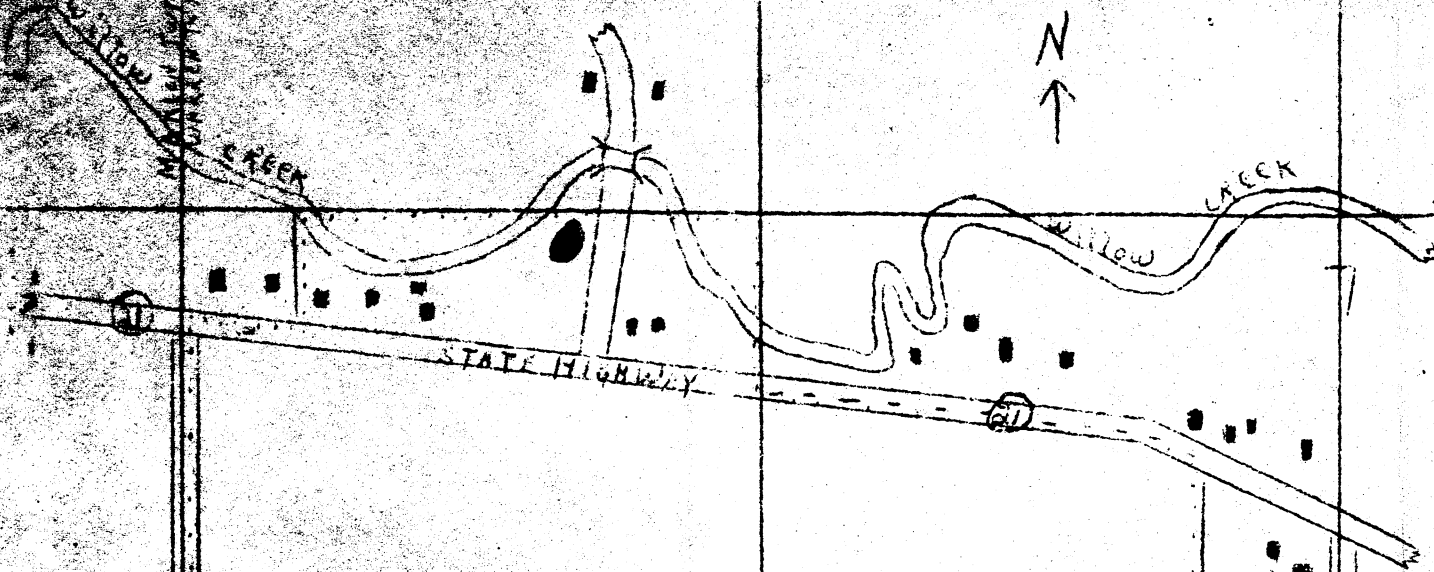
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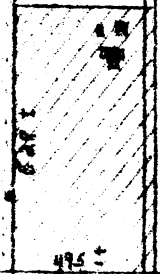

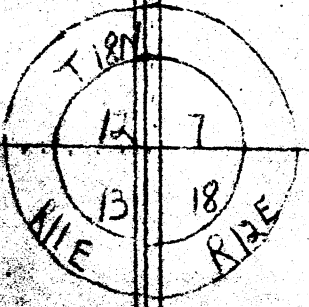
