On the application, by petition, of A. J. Reuschlein,  
W. S. Paulsen, Wm. S. Coates, Henry Row,  
Peter Palers, Alvin Cooper, and Joe M. Kowalewski

for an order that certain territory therein described be incorporated  
as a Village, said petitioners having appeared by Bentley, Kelley  
& Hill their attorneys.

And ~~residents and tax payers of said territory having appeared by their attorney against such application.~~

And there being no adverse appearance on the part  
of any residents and tax payers of said territory.

After hearing the allegations and proofs and considering  
the same the court being satisfied--

- 1. That the survey and the census annexed to such petition are correct.
- 2. That all the requirements of the statute have been complied with by such petitioners.
- 3. That the interest of the inhabitants of such territory will be promoted by such incorporation.
- 4. That the lands embraced in said territory ought justly to be included in the proposed village.
- 5. That such territory as ought to be included as aforesaid contained, at the time such census was taken, the population in number and proportion to the quantity of land therein required in section 854 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wisconsin as amended.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, that such territory, bounded and described as follows: Commencing at the  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner stone monument between Sections Nos. 5 and 8, T. 9, R. 5 E.; thence south on  $\frac{1}{4}$  line 80 rods; thence west 40 rods; thence south 80 rods to E. and west  $\frac{1}{4}$  line of section No. 8; thence west on said  $\frac{1}{4}$  line 80 rods; thence north 160 rods through the center of the S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  and N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of section No. 8 to section line; thence continue north 60 rods in the center of the S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 5, T. 9 R. 4 E.; thence east parallel with section line 160 rods to the north and south center line of the S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of section No. 5; thence south 60 rods on said center line to section line; thence west on section line 40 rods to the place of beginning, all in town 9, range 4 E., Sauk County, Wisconsin, should be incorporated as a village by the name of PLAIN, if the electors thereof shall assent thereto, as provided by law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, THAT John Weiss,  
William Coates and J. J. [unclear], residents of the town of Franklin in which said territory is situated be, and are hereby directed to perform the duties of inspectors of election as provided in Chapter 40 of the Revised Statutes to determine whether the electors of said territory assent to the incorporation thereof as a village.
