At a regular term of the Circuit Court of Racine County begun and held at the court-house in the city of Racine in said county, on the fourth Monday, being the 24th day of June A. D. 1912, and on the 27th day of June A. D. 1912 of said term. Present, Hon. E. B. Belden, Circuit Judge, presiding.

The above entitled matter having come on duly and regularly to be heard, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the court that notice of said application was duly posted on the 13th day of May 1912 in three of the most public places in the territory hereinafter described, and that there is no newspaper printed within such territory; and it further appearing that the applicants herein caused to be made an accurate survey and map of the territory intended to be embraced within the limits of such proposed village by Edwin S. Ela, a practical surveyor, as evidenced by the affidavit of said Edwin S. Ela attached to such map and survey; that said applicant also caused to be taken by J. E. Jackson, an accurate census of the resident population of such territory as the same was on the 7th day of May A. D. 1912, as evidenced by such census, and the affidavit of said J. E. Jackson thereto annexed; and it further appearing that said survey, map and census, with the verification thereof were left at the place of business within such territory, of William J. Edwards, a person residing therein, on the 13th day of May 1912, and were there kept subject to examination at all reasonable hours by every person interested for a period of five weeks from said date; that said applicants are

tax payers and residents of said territory; that more than six weeks have elapsed since the posting of said notice as aforesaid and that all of the requirements of the statutes in such case made and provided have been complied with by said applicants and that said survey and census are correct; and it appearing that at the time such census was taken the resident population of the territory proposed to be included within the boundaries of such village exceeded one hundred fifty (150) persons, and that the territory described in said application is less than one-half square mile in area, and is not included in any incorporated village, and that it all lies in the township of Rochester in the county of Racine and State of Wisconsin; and the hearing of said application having been set by said notice for this 27th day of June 1912 at the hour of ten o'clock in the forenoon,
