

The application by petition of Carl O. Doxrud, O. L. Gordon, L. H. Johnson, M. L. Gordon, George S. Diver, O. S. Swendson and H. Raasoch for an order that certain territory therein described be incorporated as a village, and said petitioners having appeared by Nelson and Murat, their attorneys, and there being no other appearance, and after hearing the allegations and proofs and considering the same, the court being satisfied, first, that the survey and census annexed to said petition are correct; second, that all the requirements of the statutes have been complied with by said petitioners; third, that the lands embraced in said territory ought justly to be included in the proposed village; fourth, that the interests of the inhabitants of said territory will be promoted by such incorporation; fifth, that said territory to be included in the proposed village contained at the time said census was taken the population in number and proportion to the quantity of land therein required by the laws of the state of Wisconsin with reference to the incorporation of villages.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, that said territory bounded and described as follows, to wit:

Commencing at the South $\frac{1}{4}$ corner between Sections 5 and 8, Town 23, North, Range 10 East, thence East on Section line 1332.5 ft. to the $\frac{1}{8}$ Corner; thence North on $\frac{1}{8}$ line 660 ft.; thence East 1332.75 ft., to a point on Section line between Section 4 and 5 660 ft. North of the Southeast Section corner of Section 5. Thence North on Section line 330 ft., thence East 1319 ft., to the West $\frac{1}{8}$ line of Section 4 990 ft. North of the South Section line; thence North on $\frac{1}{8}$ line 1650 ft., to the Northeast corner of the Northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4; thence West on $\frac{1}{4}$ line 1317 ft. to the $\frac{1}{4}$ Section corner between Section 4 and 5; thence North on Section line 1330 ft. to the Northeast corner of the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5. Thence West on $\frac{1}{8}$ line 2995 ft. to a point 330 ft. West of the North and South $\frac{1}{4}$ line; thence South Parallel to the North and South $\frac{1}{4}$ line, to the Channel of the Tomorrow River; thence down said channel to the East and West $\frac{1}{4}$ line of Section 5; thence East on ^{said} $\frac{1}{4}$ line to the center $\frac{1}{4}$ Section corner of Section 5; thence South on North and South $\frac{1}{4}$ line to a point in pond 660 ft. South of said $\frac{1}{4}$ corner; thence west 1314 ft. to the North and South $\frac{1}{8}$ line; thence South on $\frac{1}{8}$ line 1320 ft. to a point 660 ft. North of the South Section line of Section 5; thence East 1316 ft. to the North and South $\frac{1}{4}$ line; thence South on said $\frac{1}{4}$ line 660 ft. to the place of beginning, being located in Sections 4 and 5 Town 23 North, Range 10 East of 4th Principal Meridian and containing 320 acres, shall be incorporated as a village by the name of Nelsonville, if the electors thereof shall assent thereto as provided by law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That

L. L. Laborg

and

Henry Staltruberg

residents of the Town of Amherst in which said territory is situated, be and they are hereby directed to perform the duties of inspectors of election as provided by Chapter 40 of the

Wisconsin Statutes for the year 1898 and acts amendatory thereof,
to determine whether the electors of said territory assent to
the incorporation thereof as a village.
