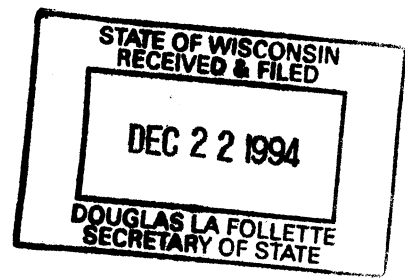

ORDINANCE NO. 6 OF 1994

RE: An Ordinance Detaching Certain Lands from the Town of Greenbush and Attaching the Same to the Village of Glenbeulah, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GLENBEULAH, SHEBOYGAN COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: After due notice to all interested parties and public hearing, and there being no objections from the State of Wisconsin, the following described lands are hereby detached from the Town of Greenbush and attached to the Village of Glenbeulah, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin:

The SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 1, Township 15 North, Range 20 East, Town of Greenbush, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin

SECTION 2: The above described lands are hereby zoned Residential District.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, publication and recording as provided by law.

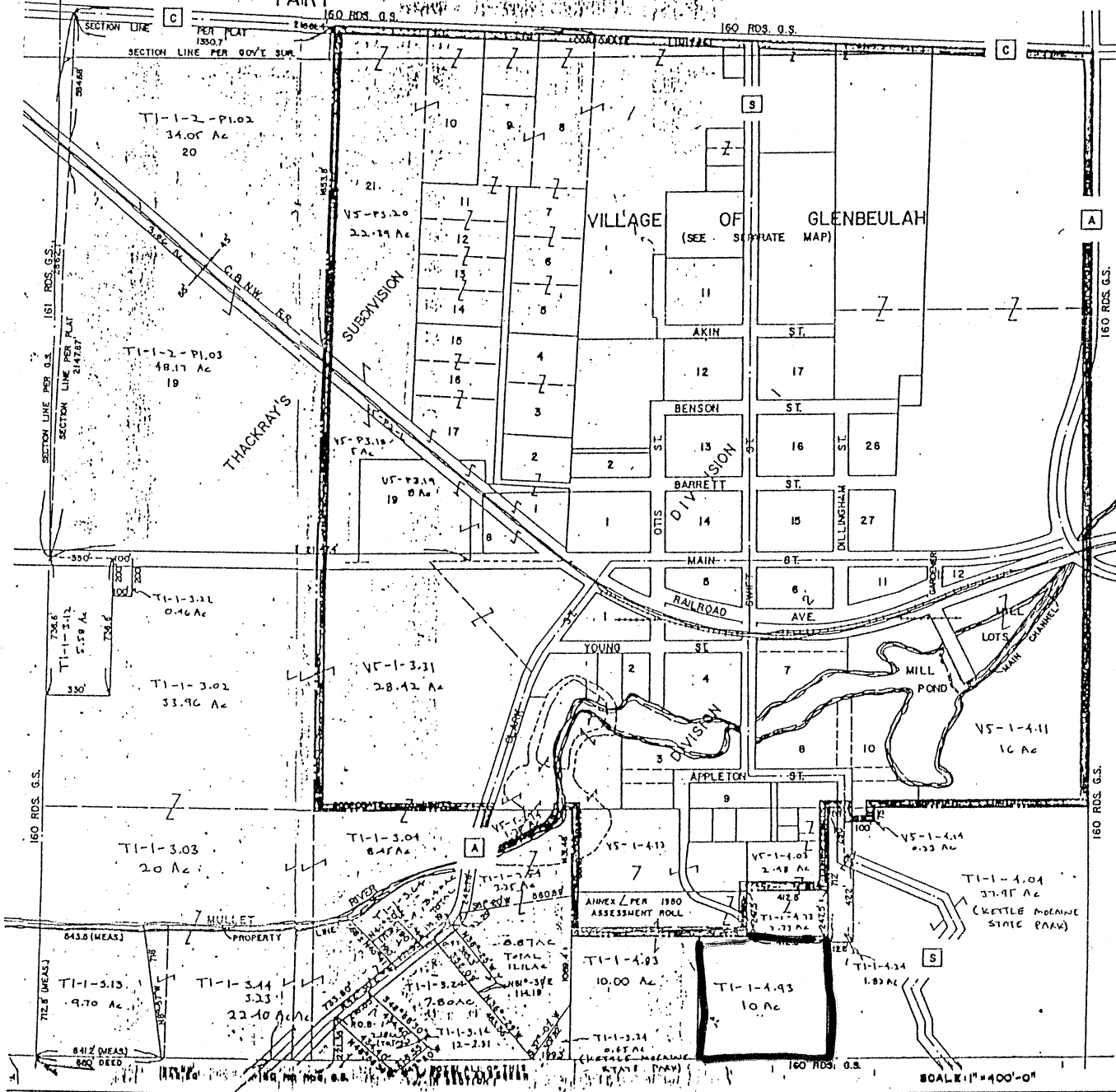

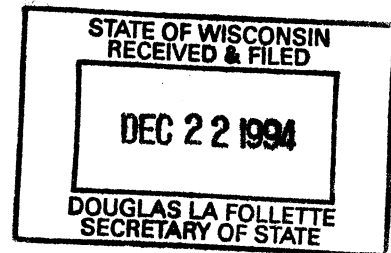
