

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING LAND TO THE VILLAGE OF GRAFTON

The Village Board of the Village of Grafton, do ordain as follows:

SECTION I. <u>Territory Annexed</u>. In accordance with Sec. 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1969, as amended, and the petition for annexation filed with the Village Clerk of the Village of Grafton on December 27, 1979 signed by the owners of at least one-half of the land in the area and one-half of the real property in assessed valuation in the territory to be annexed, the following territory in the Town of Grafton, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin is annexed to the Village of Grafton, Wisconsin:

That part of the Northwest & of Section 30, Town 10 North, Range 22 East, in the Town of Grafton, Ozaukee Countu, Wisconsin, bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the North line 535.00 feet East of the Northwest corner of said \(\frac{1}{4} \) Section, thence East along the North line of said \(\frac{1}{4} \) Section 75.00 feet to a point; thence South and parallel to the West line of said \(\frac{1}{4} \) Section 200.00 feet to a point; thence West and parallel to the North line of said \(\frac{1}{4} \) Section 75.00 feet to a point; thence North 1 \(\frac{1}{4} \) West and parallel to the West line of said \(\frac{1}{4} \) Section line 200.00 feet to the place of commencement, reserving the North 30.00 feet for highway purposes.

SECTION II. Effect of Annewation. From and after the date of this ordinance, the territory described in Section I shall be a part of the Village of Grafton for any and all purposes provided by law, and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the Village of Grafton.

SECTION III. <u>Permanent Zoning Classification</u>. Upon recommendation of the Plan Commission, the described territory is permanently designated as an R-2 Single Family Dwelling.

SECTION IV. <u>Ward Designation</u>. The territory described in Section I of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the Sixth Ward of the Village of Grafton, subject the ordinances, rules and regulations of the Village governing wards.

SECTION V. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or applications.

SECTION VI. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon passage and posting as provided by law.
