To the Honorable Circuit Court of St Croix County. the undersigned W.E.Fay, John Mitchell, D.W. Silver, Erick Albertson, A. Anderson G.W. Simonds, and Fred Rork, residents and Tax payers residing in the territory hereinafter mentioned, respectfully petition this Honerable Courtand repersent that the territory described and Mounded as follows.

Commencing at the S.E.corner of the S.E.quarter, of the N.W.quarter of Section Seven(7) in Township Thirty-one(3I)North of range Seventeen(I7) West, St Croix County Wisconsin. Thence North 480 rods Thence West 400 rods, Thence South 480 rods, thence East 400 rods to place of beginning. Contains I200 acres of land and contains a resident population of 308 as appears by census hereto attached. That they caused a Map and Survey of said territory to be made and also caused a census of the residenty inhabitants to be taken, all of which are hereto attached and proofs of their being left and kept subject to examination as provided in Section 856 R.S. which are affixed thereto.

Wherefore your petitioners pray that this Honerable Court makean order declaring that said Territory shall be an Incorporated Village by the name of Star Prairiein case the electorsthereof shall assent the reto as provided by law, and further order that three qualified persons residing in the Town in which territory lies be directed to act as and preform the duties of inspectors of election, and to call an election as provided by Section 862 of the revised Statutes.

At a regular Term of the Circuit Court of said County begun and held at the Court House in the City of Hudson, St Croix County, Wis.on the 26th day of March 1900, and on the 29th day of June 1900, present and presiding Hon E.W.Helms Circuit Judge.

The Matter of the petition of W.E.Fay, John Mitchell, D.W. Silver, Erick Albertson, Fred Rork and G.W. Simonds for the incorporation of the Vullage of Star Praime in said County having been regularly brought to a hearing, and it arrearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the following territory lies wholly within the County of St Croix aforesaid and that the same has been correctly surveyed as appears by the affidavit of John Mc Clure, the same having been duly filed, and that said territory is correctly described as follows to-wit. Commencing the south East corner of the south east quarter of the horth west quarter of section seven(7) in township Thirty one(31), north of range Seventeen((17)West Thence running horth 480 rods, Thence West 400 rods, Thence South 480 rods Thence east \$60 rods to place of beginning.

And it further appears to the satisfaction of the Court by te affidavit of W.E.Fay, the same having been duly filed ,that the cencus of the residents of said te ritory was taken on the 2Ist day of April 1900, and a that at said time said territory contained a population of 308 persons. And it further appears to the satisfaction of the Court, that all the provisions of Chapter Forty(40) of the Statutes of 1898, of Wisconsin have been complied with by said petitioners. Therefore on motion of W.F.McNally, it is ordered that the said territory above described be and the same is hereby declared an incorporated Village, and shall be known by the name of the Village od Star Prairieif the electors thereof shall assent thereto as hereinafter provided.

And it is further ordered that W.E.Fay, Henry Anderson and D.W.Silver being three persons qualified electors and residents of said territory be and they are hereby apointed inspectors of election and required without unnecessary delay to give notice of a meeting of the electors of said territory to be held within Sixty days from the date of this order, at some convenient place therein in conformity with section 862 of the Wis Statutes, of I898. for the purpose of determining whether or not such territory shall be an incorporated Village.
