

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

An Ordinance to Annex Certain Lands
To The Village of Iola

Whereas, a petition under the provisions of S. 66.021 (12) Wisconsin Statutes, 1973 as amended, having been filed with the Village Clerk by the owners of all of the real property in assessed value within such territory, for direct annexation to the Village of certain lands therein described, and

Whereas, the Village Clerk, upon report of the Village Attorney, having certified that all requirements of the Wisconsin Statutes have been complied with, and all proper and necessary papers in connection therewith have been filed with the Village Clerk, including notices and maps to the Clerk of all municipalities affected by the proposed annexation, and the head of the planning function in the department of local affairs and development, and the Clerk of the Village of Iola having received the advice of the said head of the planning function in the department of local affairs and development and the Village Board having reviewed the same, and having found nothing adverse to said proposed annexation in said advice, and having received no petition adverse to such annexation either from the public or the municipalities affected thereby,

Now, Therefore, The Village Board for the Village of Iola do ordain as follows:

I

That the following described lands, presently in the Town of Iola, Waupaca County, Wisconsin and contiguous to the Village of Iola, and described as follows:

All that part of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 36, Township 24 North, Range 11 East, lying South of State Highway 161,

be, and the same is hereby annexed to the Corporate limits of the Village of Iola.

II

That this ordinance does not affect the school district of the territory annexed.

I III

That a certified copy of this Ordinance, Certificate and scale map of the territory affected be filed with the Secretary of State of Wisconsin with the Wisconsin Power and Light Company, The

Central Wisconsin Electric Cooperative, and the Scandinavia Telephone Company, utilities serving the territory annexed, with the Register of Deeds of Waupaca County, Wisconsin, and with the Clerk of the Iola-Scandinavia Public Schools, as required by S.66.021 (8), Wisconsin Statutes, 1973, as amended.

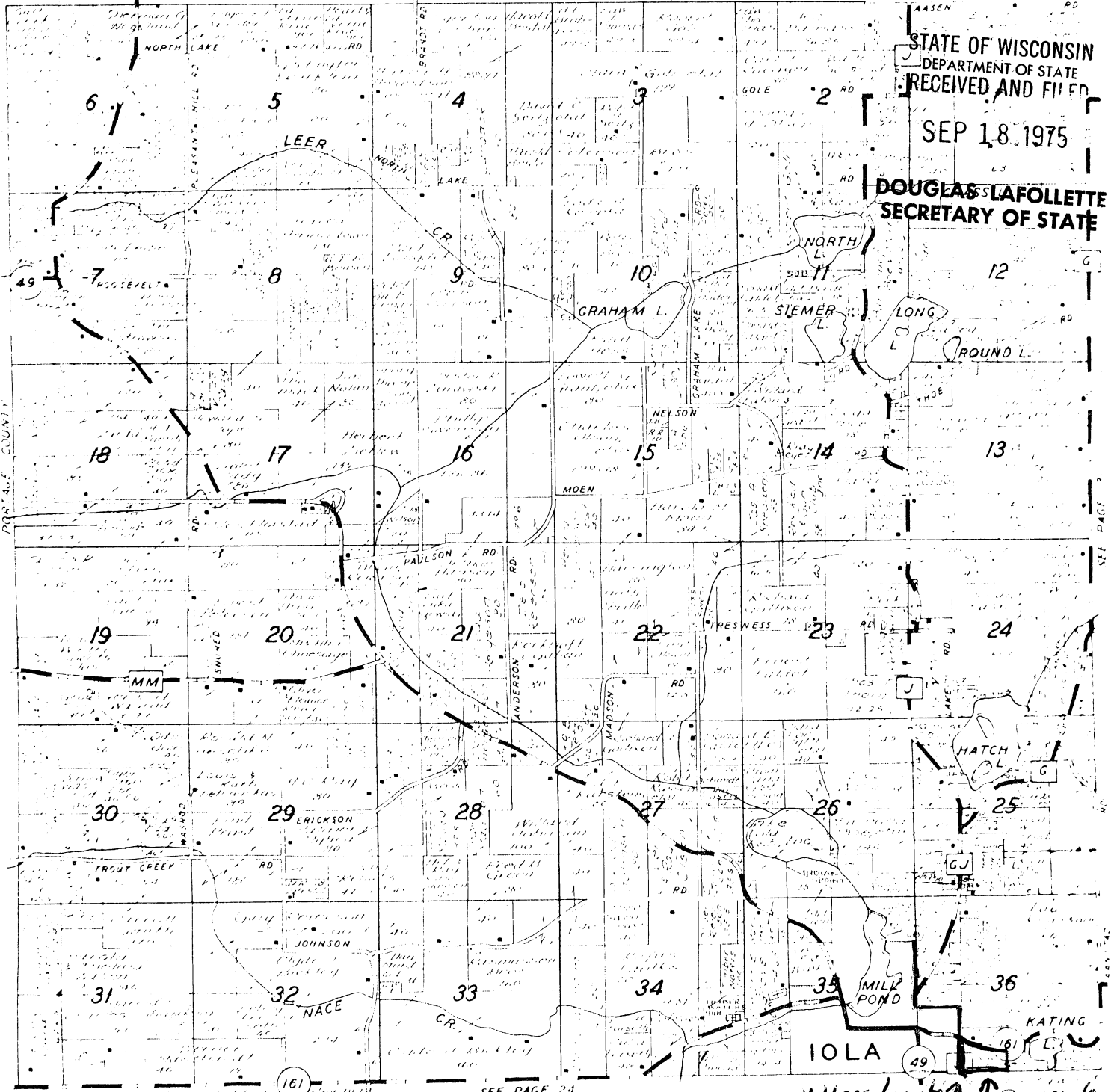
