J.V. Collins, W.F. Schmitt and John Gasser, being each duly sworn say: that they were by an order of the Circuit Court in and for Grant County, state of Wisconsin, on the 10th. day of October, A.D. 1916 directed to call an election for the purpose of submitting the question of incorporation to the qualified voters of the district comprised in said order, did call such election for the 9th. day of October, A.D. 1916 by giving the notice required by law and did on the 9th. day of November, A.D. 1916 hold such election pursuant to Chapter 40 of the Revised Statutes of the state of Wisconsin; that at said election held on said 9th. day of November A.D. 1916, there were cast eighty six votes; that seventy eight votes were "yes" and were in favor of incorporation and eight votes were "no" or against said incorporation; that the above is a true and correct statement of the vote cast and the result of said election.

The application in the above entitled matter by petition  
of more than five tax payers and residents of the territory  
to be contained in the proposed village of Blue River having  
come on to be heard upon the notice heretofore given of such  
application, and the court having examined the papers and  
proceedings herein, and being fully advised, and the Court  
after hearing the parties is satisfied of the correctness, survey  
and census filed herein, and that all the requirements of the  
statutes have been fully complied with, and the Court being  
further satisfied that the lands embraced in such territory  
as appears by the survey herein ought justly to be included in  
the proposed village of Blue River, and the Court being  
further satisfied that the interests of the inhabitants of the  
said territory will be promoted by incorporation, and that  
the territory that ought to be included is the territory  
contained in the survey herein, that at the time such census  
was first taken there were three hundred fifty five people  
residing in said territory, and that the population and number  
in proportion to the quantity of land therein appears to be  
in compliance with as required in Section 854 of the  
Revised Statutes; and the Court being fully advised and being  
satisfied that the law has been fully complied with.

Now, therefore, on motion of R.M. Orchard, attorney  
for said petitioners, it is hereby ordered, decreed and adjudged,  
and the Court doth hereby order and adjudge and decree,  
That the following described territory, to-wit:-

Beginning at the North East corner of Section Eleven (11) Town Eight (8) North of Range Two (2) West of the Fourth principal Meridian, according to Government Survey, thence due East Eighty (80) rods, thence due South three hundred twenty (320) rods, thence due West eighty rods (80), thence due North forty (40) rods, thence due West two hundred forty (240) rods, thence due North two hundred eighty (280) rods, thence due East two hundred forty (240) rods, to place of beginning, containing 420 acres in Section Eleven (11) and sixt een acres in Section Twelve (12), in all Five Hundred Eighty Acres, in Grant County, Wisconsin.

Shall be and is hereby declared to be incorporated Village by the name of Blue River, if the electors thereof shall assent thereto as provided in Section 861 of the Revised Statutes of this state.

And it is further ordered and directed that W.F. Schmitt, J.V. Collins and John Gasser, tax payers and residents of the town in which the above described territory lies, and residents of said territory, be, and they are hereby appointed to perform the duties of inspectors of election as required of them by Chapter 40 of the Revised Statutes; to call a meeting of the electors of the said territory to be held and conducted as provided by Sections 862, 863, 864 and 865 of the revised Statutes of this state, and to do all other things as by law required of them to do.
