Circuit Court Waupaca County.

In the Matter of the Incorporation of the  
Village of Embarrass, in said County.

At a general term of said Court, held in the County of  
Wood and State of Wisconsin, being a Special term of said Court, for Waupaca  
County, held in the Court House in the City of Grand Rapids, Wood County, Wis.  
on the 13th day of May A.D. 1895, and at the first day of said term, -present  
Hon. C.M. Webb, Judge Presiding. The above entitled matter coming on to be  
heard upon the records and proceedings, papers and files, and upon due proofs  
made of the making of the survey maps and census as required by law, and that  
the same were left for inspection at a business place within said territory  
as provided by law and that due notices were posted within said proposed

territory for more than six weeks notifying all persons interested of the time and place of the hearing of said Petition, which said notices contained an accurate description of the lands proposed to be included in said petition, the courses, distances and area. As provided by law, and that the interests of the inhabitants of said proposed territory will be best promoted by such Incorporation, and that such territory as ought to be included in said Incorporation contained at the time such census was taken the population in number and in proportion to the quantity of land therein, required by law.

And said Petitioners having appeared in Court by F. M. Guernsey, their Attorney and made and filed a petition as required by law, and no one appearing to contest such petition, On Motion of F. M. Guernsey;— Ordered and

Adjudged,

That the following described territory to-wit:

Shall be an Incorporated village by the name of the Village of Embarrass, if the electors thereof shall assent thereto as provided by provisions of Statute. It is further ordered that George Delaney, C. B. Smith and George Beedle, act as and perform the duties of Inspectors of Election to be held under the provisions of Chapter 40 of the Revised Statutes of Wisconsin.

For a Village Election to be held in and for the village of Embarrass, on the 8th day of June 1895 for the purpose of determining the question of incorporation of said village.

And, that after being satisfied that due notice had been given did proceed to hold said election in accordance with said order and notice at the warehouse of J. T. Curtis in said village, and that the whole number of votes polled was fifty nine of which thirty eight were marked for incorporation yes, and eighteen were marked for incorporation No. and three were Blank, and that said election was by us declared carried in favor of incorporation.
