



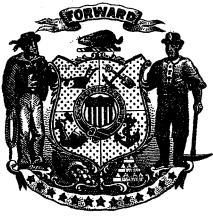

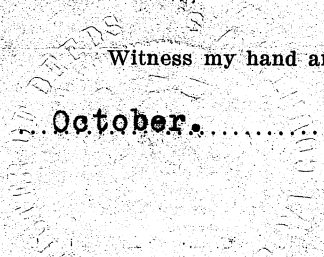

State of Wisconsin, Circuit Court for Chippewa County.

At a general term of the Circuit Court⁷ of the 11th Judicial Circuit of the State of Wisconsin, begun and holden within and for the County of Chippewa at the Court House in the City of Chippewa Falls, on the 2nd day of October, 1894. Honorable R. D. Marshall, Judge, presiding the 5th day of February 1895.

The Matter of the petition of James H. Munroe and others, for the incorporation of the Village of Cadott.

Order

The above matter being called up at the opening of Court on this day, and the "petitioners" having appeared by W. M. Bowe, their Attorney, and filed and presented their petition, and there being no opposition thereto, and no person appearing against the application therein contained, and the Court being satisfied from the petition and affidavits filed therewith of the correctness of the survey and census presented with the petition, and that the requirements of the Statutes have been complied with and that the lands embraced in the territory described in the petition, ought justly to be included in the proposed Village, and that the interest of the inhabitants will be promoted by the incorporation thereof, and that said territory at the time the census was taken, had population in number and proportion to the quantity of land required by law.

Now on Motion of W. M. Bowe, Attorney for the petitioners, It is ordered that the territory named in the petition be and the same is hereby incorporated, and the same shall be and incorporated village by the name of the Village of Cadott.

The following is a description of the boundaries of said village by

and distances, namely:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section Thirty, in Township Twenty nine, Range six West, and running thence East on the quarter line one and one half miles to the Northeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of the SouthWest quarter of Section Twenty nine of Township Twenty nine, in Range six West, Thence South on the quarter line Two miles to the South East corner of the South East quarter of the North west quarter of Section Five, in Township Twenty eight of Range Six West, Thence West on the quarter line One and one half miles to the south west corner of the South West quarter of the North West quarter of Section Six, in Township Twenty eight, Range six West, Thence North on the Range line between range six and seven Two miles to the place of beginning. The said boundaries including the South WestQuarter of Section twenty nine, The South half of section Thirty. All of Section Thirty one, The West half of Section Thirty Two, all in Township, Twenty nine North Range six West, The North West quarter of Section Five, The North half of Section six, in Township Twenty eight, Range six West. The same containing 1920 acres, or Three square miles of land, according to Government survey, and being wholly situated in the town of Sigel, Chippewa County, Wisconsin

Ordered Further, that James H. Munroe, Frank Zimmerman and Clark Watson of the said town of Sigel be and are hereby appointed and directed to perform the duties of Inspectors of election as required by Chapter 40 of the revised Statutes of Wisconsin and acts amendatory thereof.
