


ORDINANCE NO. 5-2-90

An Ordinance Annexing Certain Lands to the Village of Slinger, Washington County, Wisconsin

WHEREAS, A Petition for Direct Annexation together with a scale map of the area to be annexed has been filed with the Village Clerk of the Village of Slinger, and

WHEREAS, a proof of service of said Petition and map on the Town Clerk of the Town of Polk, Washington County, Wisconsin, has been filed, and

WHEREAS, a proof of mailing of said Petition and map to the Department of Local Affairs and Development, Bureau of Local and Regional Planning, State of Wisconsin, has been filed, and

WHEREAS, said lands are contiguous to the Village of Slinger, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that said Petition was signed by all of the owners of all of the land in the area to be annexed and all of the electors residing within said area, and

WHEREAS, it is determined that the area to be annexed does not constitute more than one square mile, and



WHEREAS, it has been determined that by annexation of the area described in the Pettition no town area will be created which is completely surrounded by the Village of Slinger,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Slinger, Washington County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION I. The following described property, to-wit:

That part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 7, Township 10 North, Range 19 East described as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of Lot 106 in Park Addition to Slinger and running thence North 1171.2 feet, thence West at right angles 840.9 feet to the easterly line of the Minneapolis, St. Paul and Sault St. Marie Railway right of way, thence South 2 degrees 44 minutes East along said easterly line of right of way of said railway 413.5 feet, thence South 47 degrees 18 minutes East 1118 feet to point of beginning.


