The application for the incorporation of the Village of Hawkins coming on for hearing before the court, J. W. Carow appearing for the applicants and no one appearing in opposition, and the court being satisfied of the correctness of the survey and census, that all the requirements of the statutes have been complied with and that such territory as is proposed to be included, contained at the time such census was first taken the population in number and in proportion to the quantity of land therein required by law;

ON MOTION OF J. W. CAROW, Attorney for Applicants;

IT IS ORDERED AND DECLARED that the following described territory, (all of Section Number Fourteen (14), East One-half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Number Fifteen (15), Northeast Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Number Twenty-two (22) and the North One-half ($N\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Number Twenty-three (23), all in Township Number Thirty-five (35) North, Range Number Three (3) West, Rusk County, Wisconsin, and the boundaries of such territory by courses and distances are as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Section Number Fourteen (14) thence west 7757 feet to the center of said Section Number fifteen (15); thence south 7922 feet to the center of said Section Number Twenty-two (22); thence east 7817.8 feet to the east section line of said Section Number Twenty-three (23); thence north ^{7925 feet} to point of beginning; said territory containing two and one-quarter square miles,

shall be an incorporated village by the name of Hawkins, if the electors thereof shall assent thereto as provided by law;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND DECLARED that the following named persons of the town of Hawkins, said county, shall perform the duties of inspectors of election herein as provided by law, to-wit; O. L. Hotz, Fred Karlman and G. O. Vig.

STATEMENT OF RESULT OF ELECTION.

We, the undersigned, having been by an order of the Circuit Court for Rusk County, Wisconsin, made on the 1st. day of August, 1922, duly appointed inspectors of an election to be held pursuant to said order within and for the territory described therein located within the town of Hawkins, Rusk County, Wisconsin, for the purpose of determining by a vote of the qualified electors of said territory whether or not said territory should be incorporated as a village by the name of the village of Hawkins, do hereby state:

That pursuant to said order we did on the 3rd. day of August, 1922, call a meeting of the electors of said territory for said purpose, to be held at the Old Lutheran Church Building in said territory on the 30th. day of August, 1922, and caused a notice thereof to be published in the Hawkins Chronicle, a weekly newspaper published in said territory, once a week for three successive weeks previous to such meeting, a copy of which notice is hereto attached and marked "Exhibit A"; That said election was held pursuant to said notice.

That immediately after closing the polls we canvassed the votes cast at said election, the total votes cast being 92, number of votes in favor of incorporation, 69; number of votes against incorporation, 23; that the election resulted in favor of the incorporation of said village, that immediately after the canvass of said votes was completed, O. L. Hotz, one of the inspectors, made a public proclamation of the result.
