A CHARTER ORDINANCE

RELATING TO THE SELECTION AND TENURE OF THE VILLAGE
ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICIALS

The Village Board of the Village of Wales do ordain as follows:

- Section 1. Pursuant to sections 61.195, 61.197, and 66.01 of the Wisconsin statutes, the Village of Wales hereby elects not to be governed by those portions of sections 61.19 and 61.23 of the statutes which relate to the selection and tenure of the village assessor, clerk, and treasurer, and which are in conflict with this ordinance.
- Section 2. Hereafter, instead of being elected, the assessor, clerk, and treasurer of the Village of Wales shall be appointed by vote of a majority of the members-elect of the village board.
- Section 3. The term of said assessor, clerk, and treasurer shall be for two years, and until their successors are selected and qualify. Such term shall begin on May first succeeding their election.
- Section 4. This ordinance shall not in any way affect the right of any person whose term of office has begun but has not expired on the effective date of this ordinance, to complete his term of office.
- Section 5. This is a charter ordinance and shall take effect 60 days after its passage and publication, unless within such 60 days a referendum petition shall be filed as provided by section 66.01 of the Wisconsin statutes, in which event this ordinance shall not take effect until submitted to a referendum and approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.
