

Part of Sections 1 and 12, Town 7 North, Range 9 East, part of Section 36, Town 8 North, Range 9 East and part of Section 31, Town 8 North, Range 10 East, Dane County, Wisconsin, to-wit: Beginning at the point of intersection of the center line of Lakewood Boulevard with the center line of Sherman Avenue, said point also being 50.0 feet North of the Southeast corner of Section 1, Town 7 North, Range 9 East; thence Northerly along said center line of Sherman Avenue to its point of intersection with the extended South line of Oxford Place; thence Easterly, along said extended South line of Oxford Place, to the Northeasterly right-of-way line of the Chicago & North-Western Railway; thence Northwesterly, along said Northeasterly right-of-way line of railway, to its point of intersection with the Extended South line of Warner Park; thence Westerly, along said South line of park and said line extended, to the low water mark of Lake Mendota; thence in a general Southerly direction along said low water mark of lake to its point of intersection with the North line of Burrows Park, said line also being the South line of Burrows Road and said line extended, and said line also being referred to as being 566 feet South of and parallel to the North line of Fractional Lot 1 of Section 12, Town 7 North, Range 9 East; thence Easterly, along said North line of park, to the center line of Sherman Avenue; thence Northeasterly, along said center line of avenue, to its point of intersection with the center line of Old Shore Road; thence Northwesterly, along said center line of Old Shore Road, to its point of intersection with the Southerly extension of the East line of Block B of the recorded Replat of Blocks 2, 3 and 4, Baywood Replat; thence North, along said East line of Block B and its extensions thereof, to the center line of Lakewood Boulevard; thence Easterly, along said center line of boulevard, to the point of beginning. Also part of Section 12, Town 7 North, Range 9 East, Dane County, Wisconsin, to-wit: Beginning at the point of intersection of the low water mark of Lake Mendota with the South line of fractional Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 12; thence Easterly, along said South line of fractional quarter, to the center line of Sherman Avenue; thence Northeasterly along said center line of avenue to its point of intersection with the South line of Burrows Park, said point being 345 feet South plus 744 feet Southwesterly, along the center line of Sherman Avenue, from the Northeast corner of Government Lot 1, Section 12; thence Westerly, along said South line of Burrows Park to its point of intersection with a North and South line which is parallel to and 46.15 feet East of the East line of Lot 13, Block 3 of the recorded plat of Fuller's Woods; thence South, along last described line, 88.27 feet; thence West, parallel to the South line of Government Lot 1 of Section 12, a distance of 255 feet; thence North, on a line parallel to said East line of Lot 13, Block 3, Fuller's Woods, 88.27 feet; thence Westerly, along South line of Burrows Park to the low water mark of Lake Mendota; thence Southerly, along said low water mark of lake, to the point of beginning.
