ORDER OF INCORPORATION

THE ABOVE ENTITLED HEARING coming on to be heard on the 2nd day of June 1939 and the verified survey, map and census of the area proposed to be incorporated as a village as well as the petition of five resident taxpayers of said proposed area being placed on file with the court and after examination and consideration by the court; and the Court after such examination and consideration being satisfied that the survey, map and census are correct and that all of the requirements of the statutes have been complied with for incorporation of the proposed area as a village, and that said proposed area contains a population in excess of 150 persons resident within said area:

IT IS ORDERED that said proposed area described by courses and bounds as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the center of the West line of the Northwest one-quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Twenty Town Ten North Range One West; thence run East Eighty rods, more or less, to land now belonging to H.T.Berry, at the middle point in the East line of said forty; thence run South along the said forty line a distance of forty rods, more or less, to land now belonging to the said H.T.Berry; thence continuing South along the same line extended a distance of One hundred twenty rods, more or less, to the middle point in the East line of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section Twenty on land now belonging to Harold Fleming; thence run West a distance of One hundred sixty rods, more or less, to the center of County Trunk Highway " E ", thence run North along the center line of said highway a distance of forty rods, more or less, to land now belonging to Irwin Carter; thence continuing North along land of said Carter a distance of eighty rods, more or less, to land now belonging to Oscar Olson, thence continuing North through land of said Olson a distance of forty rods, more or less, to the middle point in the West line of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section Nineteen, Town Ten North, Range One West, thence run East a distance of eighty rods, more or less, through land now belonging to Herbert Kirchner to place of beginning. Said tract of land contains One hundred sixty acres, more or less.

Be incorporated as the Village of Boaz, Richland County, Wisconsin if the electors within said proposed area to be incorporated give their assent thereto at an election held in accordance with the statutes governing such incorporation proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Ernest W. Koch, O.A. Oliver and Frank Harris, residents and electors living within said proposed area, be and hereby are appointed as inspectors of election of the election to be held to determine whether or not the electors of said proposed area give their assent to the incorporation of said Village of Boaz.

This is to certify that we the undersigned inspectors of a referendum election held within the area proposed to be incorporated as the Village of Boaz, Richland County, Wisconsin to determine whether or not such village should be incorporated, did hold such election on the 24th day of June 1939 pursuant to an Order of Hon. S.E. Smalley, Circuit Judge of Richland County and that the persons voting at such election all were residents and electors living within said area which said area is described by courses and bounds in said Order of the Circuit Court aforesaid; that the whole number of votes cast at such election was 107, of which 79 were For Incorporation and 28 were Against Incorporation. Said election was held at Kypke's Hall at Boaz, Wis. and the polls of the election were open from 9:00 A.M. until 5:30 P.M. of June 24th, 1939.
