The Village Board of the Village of West Baraboo do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Sections 61.195, 61.197 and 66.01 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Village of West Baraboo elects not to be governed by those portions of ss. 61.19 and 61.23 relating to the selection and tenure of constable and marshal and hereby abolishes the offices of constable and marshal.

There is hereby created the office of village chief SECTION 2. of police who shall be appointed by a vote of a majority of the members elect of the Village Board.

The term of said Chief of Police shall be for two SECTION 3. (2) years and until a successor shall be selected and qualify.

SECTION 4. Such Chief of Police shall have the powers, privileges and duties of village marshals and village constables under ss. 61.28 and 61.29, Wisconsin Statutes, and shall perform such other duties as may be required from time to time by the village board.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall not in any way affect the right of any person whose term of office has begun but has not expired on the effective date of this ordinance to complete his term of office.

SECTION 6. This is a charter ordinance and shall take effect 60 days after its passage and publication, unless within such 60 days a referendum petition shall be filed as provided by S. 66.01 of the Wisconsin Statutes, in which event this ordinance shall not take effect until submitted to a referendum and approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.
