The petition of George Dorfmeister, Robert Bulen, Halvor Olson, Walter Ketter, ~~Harold Korr~~, ^{IRA BUTLER} Fred Marks, and Charles Howland, applying for an order incorporating the "VILLAGE OF NASHOTAH", having come on to be heard before the said Court, HONORABLE ALLEN D. YOUNG, Circuit Judge, presiding; said petitioners appearing by LOVE, DAVIS, McGRAW & FREY, represented by GLENN R. DAVIS, there being no appearance in opposition to the petition for incorporation; and the Court having taken testimony and being fully advised in the premises;

THE COURT NOW FINDS:

1. That the verified survey in Exhibit "A", the verified map in Exhibit "B", and the verified census in Exhibit "C", annexed and made a part of said petition are, in all respects, true and correct.
2. That the requirements of the applicable statutes of the State of Wisconsin have been met and complied with in these proceedings.
3. That the area of the territory proposed to be incorporated, described in said Exhibits "A" and "B", and the population of the residents therein listed in said Exhibit "C", are in accord with Section 61.01 of the Wisconsin Statutes at the time of this application.
4. That all of the allegations in said petition are true and correct.
5. That the territory sought to be incorporated has all the characteristics of a village, and is a village in fact.
6. That the boundaries of the territory hereinafter declared to be an incorporated village, by courses and distances, are as follows:

All that part of the West One Half (1/2) of Section No. 5 and all of the East One Half (1/2) of Section No. 6 Township No. 7 North, Range No. 18 East, in the Town of Delafield, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the South East corner of said section No. 6 and the South West corner of said Section No. 5; and thence North 1°23'30" West along the West line of the said section No. 5 525.0 feet; thence North 89°06'30" East and parallel with the South line of the West One Half of said Section No. 5 1959.64 feet; thence North 1°47'28" West, 50.0 feet; thence North 85° 01'50" East, 502.95 feet; thence North 0°13' 14" East, 388.0 feet; thence North 89°06' 30" East, 200.0 feet to the East line of the West One Half of said section No. 5; thence North 1°47'28" West on said East line, 1476.87 feet; thence South 86° 23' 30" West, 680.0 feet more or less; thence North 41° 07' 30" East, 40.0 feet; thence North 25° 51'30" East, 160.0 feet; thence North 37°00'30" East, 183.60 feet; thence North 4° 51'30" East, 199.80 feet; thence North 86°29'30" West, 272.90 feet; thence North 70°44'30" West, 302.15 feet; thence South 87°28' 30" West and parallel with the East-West Quarter line of the said Section No. 5, 386.80 feet; thence North 2°15' 30" West, 306.30 feet to the Southeasterly line of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad Right-of-way; thence North 72° 42' 30" East along the Southeasterly line of said right-of-way, 1442.03 feet to said East line of West One Half of said Section No. 5; thence North 1°47'28" West on said East line, 2163.20 feet to the North east corner of the West One Half of said Section No. 5; thence South 88°01'20" West on the North line of the West One Half of said Section No. 5, 2652.68 feet to the North West corner of the said Section No. 5 and the North East corner of the said Section No. 6; thence North 87°53'33" West on the North line of the East One Half of said Section No. 6, 2625.45 feet to the North West corner of the East One Half of said Section No. 6; thence South 1°07' East along the West line of the East One Half of said Section No. 6, 5583.05 feet to the South West corner of the East One Half of the said Section No. 6; thence North 84°34'30" East on the South line of the East One Half of said Section No. 6, 2674.00 feet to the point of commencement.

Total Area 638.65 Acres, or 0.9979 square miles.

NOW, THEREFORE, upon the said findings and upon all of the records, documents, files and proceedings herein, and upon motion of LOVE, DAVIS, MCGRAW & FREY, attorneys for said petitioners,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the territory, the boundaries of which are hereinbefore set forth in courses and distances, shall be and hereby is made and declared to be an incorporated village, by the name of "VILLAGE OF NASHOTAH", if the electors thereof shall assent thereto in the election as herein provided.

2. That Henry Volkman, Harold Kerr and R. E. Howland of the Town of Delafield, County of Waukesha and State of Wisconsin, the town in which such territory lies, are hereby named as inspectors of election.

3. That such inspectors of election shall, without unnecessary delay, give notice of a meeting of the electors of such territory to be held within sixty days of the date of this order, at some convenient place therein, to be specified in such notice, for the purpose of determining whether such territory shall be an incorporated village; that such notice of election shall be posted in at least three of the most public places in such territory at least three weeks previous to such meeting.

4. That such inspectors of election shall preside and act as inspectors of election and shall designate one of their number or some other person to act as clerk thereof; and that the ballots and the manner of conducting such election shall conform to the applicable statutes thereto.


5. That such inspectors of election shall make a verified statement of the holding of such meeting, showing the whole number of votes cast, the number cast for incorporation, and the number cast against incorporation; and that such verified statement shall be recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for Waukesha County, Wisconsin.

6. That if a majority of the votes cast at such election meeting shall be against incorporation, no further proceedings shall be had in respect to such incorporation.

7. That if a majority of the votes cast at such election meeting shall be in favor of such incorporation, the inhabitants of the territory hereinbefore described shall, from the time of the recording of this order in the office of the Register of Deeds for Waukesha County, Wisconsin, be deemed a body corporate by the name of "VILLAGE OF NASHOTAH."

that the polls were opened at nine o'clock in the morning and remained open until five-thirty o'clock in the evening of said date, and that there were duly cast at said election ONE HUNDRED TWENTY THREE (123) votes of which NINETY NINE (99) were for incorporation and TWENTY FOUR (24) were against incorporation and that there were NO (0) blank ballots cast, and that more than a majority of the votes cast at said election were for incorporation, as appears from the number of votes cast as hereinbefore set forth; that a statement and tally sheet of said election is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Affiants further severally state that they have caused the said statement and tally sheet to be made in triplicate, and the poll register to be made in duplicate, and pursuant to Sections 6.45 and 6.59, Wisconsin Statutes, they have delivered one statement and tally sheet and poll register to the county clerk of Waukesha County on the 11th day of September, 1957, and that they are retaining another statement and tally sheet and poll register to be delivered to the Village Clerk when, and as soon as, he shall be duly elected and qualified, to be by him filed and preserved in his office.

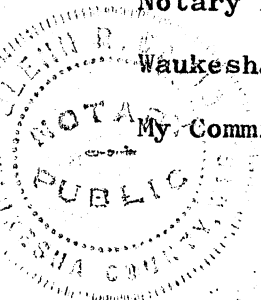
