

CERTIFICATE OF ANNEXATION

I, Blanche Kornely, Village Clerk of the Village of Francis Creek, County of Manitowoc, State of Wisconsin, do hereby certify that the following described territory was detached from the Town of Kossuth, County of Manitowoc, and was annexed to the said Village of Francis Creek pursuant to Section 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes, by an Ordinance adopted by the Village Board at a regular meeting held March 1, 1979; and the population of said territory is 47.

The West One-half of the Northeast Quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} NE\frac{1}{4}$); the East thirty-five (35) acres of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4} NW\frac{1}{4}$); and the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4} SE\frac{1}{4}$); all in Section Fifteen (15), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Twenty-three (23) East;

That part of the East One-half of the Northeast Quarter ($E\frac{1}{2} NE\frac{1}{4}$) lying West of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad, EXCEPTING therefrom that part of the above-described real estate presently located within the incorporated boundary of the Village of Francis Creek, WI, all being in Section Fifteen (15), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Twenty-three (23) East, Manitowoc Co., WI.

ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE
VILLAGE OF FRANCIS CREEK, WISCONSIN

The Village Board of the Village of Francis Creek,
Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with Section 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes and the Petition for Direct Annexation including the scale map and description of the territory proposed to be annexed filed with the Village Clerk on the 3rd day of January, 1979, and the Petition for Direct Annexation and Consent to Join Petition for Annexation including the scale map and description filed with the Village Clerk on the 17th day of February, 1979, signed by the electors residing in the territory proposed to be annexed and by the owners of all the real estate in the territory, the following described territory in the Town of Kossuth, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the Village of Francis Creek, Wisconsin:

The West One-half of the Northeast Quarter ($W\frac{1}{2}$ $NE\frac{1}{4}$); the East thirty-five (35) acres of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$ $NW\frac{1}{4}$); and the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$ $SE\frac{1}{4}$); all in Section Fifteen (15), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Twenty-three (23) East;

That part of the East One-half of the Northeast Quarter ($E\frac{1}{2}$ $NE\frac{1}{4}$) lying West of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad, EXCEPTING therefrom that part of the above-described real estate presently located within the incorporated boundary of the Village of Francis Creek, WI, all being in Section Fifteen (15), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Twenty-three (23) East, Manitowoc Co., WI.

SECTION 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance the territory described in Section 1 shall be a part of the Village of Francis Creek for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the Village of Francis Creek.

SECTION 3. Time Limits. That more than twenty days

have elapsed since service of notice on the Head of Planning Function, Department of Local Affairs and Development of the original Petition for Direct Annexation and that no notice or reply contrary to said annexation has been received from said Department. That not more than sixty days have elapsed since the date of filing with the Village Clerk of the Petitions for annexation.

SECTION 4. Schools. That said territory is within the Mishicot School District #1.

SECTION 5. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

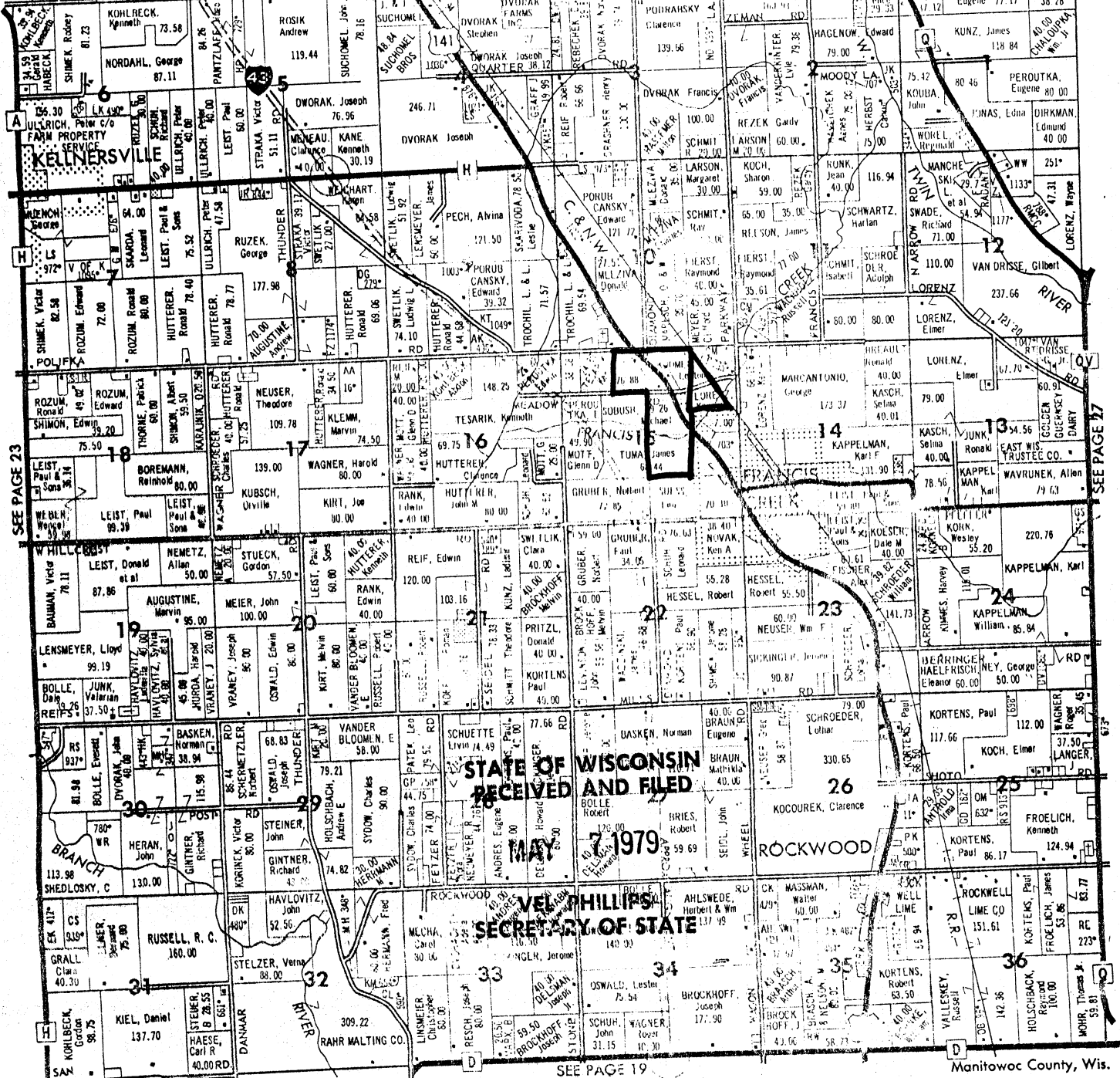
