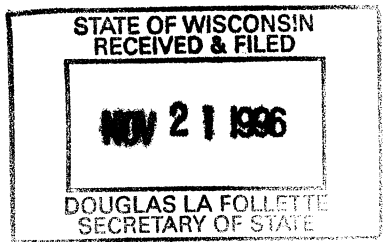

 SECTION 1. Pursuant to secs. 66.01 and
 61.195 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Village of
 Oakdale hereby elects not to be governed by
 those portions of secs. 61.19, 61.28 and 61.29
 of the Wisconsin Statutes which are in conflict
 with this ordinance.
 SECTION 2. Effective immediately, the
 offices of Village Marshal and Constable are
 discontinued and abolished.
 SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordi-
 nances in conflict herewith are hereby
 repealed.
 SECTION 4. This is a charter ordinance and
 shall take effect 60 days after its passage and
 publication unless within such 60-day period a
 referendum petition as provided by sec.
 66.01(5) of the Wisconsin Statutes shall be
 filed, in which event this ordinance shall not
 take effect until it shall have been submitted to
 a referendum vote of the electors and
 approved by a majority of the electors voting
 thereon.

VILLAGE CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 1

CHARTER ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE OFFICES OF
MARSHAL AND CONSTABLE

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF OAKDALE, MONROE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to secs. 66.01 and 61.195 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Village of Oakdale hereby elects not to be governed by those portions of secs. 61.19, 61.28 and 61.29 of the Wisconsin Statutes which are in conflict with this ordinance.

SECTION 2. Effective immediately, the offices of Village Marshal and Constable are discontinued and abolished.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This is a charter ordinance and shall take effect 60 days after its passage and publication unless within such 60 day period a referendum petition as provided by sec. 66.01(5) of the Wisconsin Statutes shall be filed, in which event this ordinance shall not take effect until it shall have been submitted to a referendum vote of the electors and approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.
