ORDINANCE NO. 05-98 RECOMMENDED BY PLANNING COMMISSION STATE OF WISCONSIN RECEIVED & FILED AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF RHINELANDER, JUN 2 3 1998 WISCONSIN: THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RHINELANDER DO ORDAIN AS

WHEREAS, the City of Rhinelander, pursuant to Ord. 26-97, annexed property to the City of Rhinelander pursuant to a petition for direct annexation filed with the City Clerk on October 3, 1997; and

WHEREAS, the legal description included in Ord. 26-97 was incorrect;

NOW THEREFORE, the following annexation correction shall be made as follows:

SECTION 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with §66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1995-1996, and the petition for direct annexation filed with the City Clerk on October 3, 1997, signed by the sole owner of the property within the area described below, located in the Town of Crescent, Oneida County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the City of Rhinelander, Wisconsin.

Description

A parcel of land located in the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4, Section 1, T 36 N, R 8 E, Town of Crescent, Oneida County, Wisconsin described as follows: Commencing at the center of said Section 1, thence S 00°08'22" E a distance of 828.76' to an iron pipe on the southerly right of way line of Davenport Street and point of beginning, thence continuing S 00°08'22" E a distance of 273.75' to an iron pipe on the northerly right of way line of the Wisconsin Central Railroad, thence easterly along said right of way line a distance of 425.00' to a point, thence leaving said right of way line northerly to a point on the southerly right of way line of Davenport Street which is 300.00' easterly of the point of beginning, thence westerly along said right of way line 300.00' to the point of beginning.

FOLLOWS:

SECTION 2. Effect of Annexation. For and after the date of this ordinance the territory described in Section 1 shall be a part of the City of Rhinelander for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Rhinelander.

SECTION 3. Zoning Classification. Upon the recommendation of the Planning Commission, the territory annexed to the City of Rhinelander by this ordinance is designated as B-3, General Business District, subject to the zoning restrictions related to such zoning classifications in the City of Rhinelander.

SECTION 4. Ward Designation. The territory described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the 14th ward of the City of Rhinelander, subject to ordinances, rules and regulations of the City governing wards.

SECTION 5. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions of applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision of applications.

SECTION 6. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
