

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS
OF THE TOWN OF PEWAUKEE TO THE CITY
OF WAUKESHA, WISCONSIN

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAUKESHA DO ORDAIN AS
FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In accordance with Section 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes and petition for annexation filed with the City Clerk on the 17th day of October, 1977, the following described territory in the Town of Pewaukee, Waukesha County, Wisconsin is annexed to the City of Waukesha, Wisconsin:

Lot numbered Five (5) in Lambert Heights, being a Sub-division of a part of the South East One-quarter (1/4) and North East One-quarter (1/4) of the South West One-Quarter (1/4) of Section numbered Twenty-eight (28), in Township numbered Seven (7) North, Range numbered Nineteen (19) East, in the Town of Pewaukee, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, and containing approximately 0.34 acres.

SECTION 2. The following shall be zoned pursuant to the authority granted in 66.021(7) of the Wisconsin Statutes as R-2, One- Family Residence District.

SECTION 3. The annexed territory is hereby made a part of the Fifth Aldermanic District of the City of Waukesha, and is annexed for all municipal purposes including annexation for school purposes, and is hereby made a part of the City School District, and subject to all laws governing the same.

SECTION 4. The City limits of the City of Waukesha, Wisconsin are hereby changed and enlarged so as to include the real estate described in Section 1 of this ordinance, and the official map is amended to include said real estate.

SECTION 5. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remainder shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or contravening the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after it passage and publication as provided by law.
