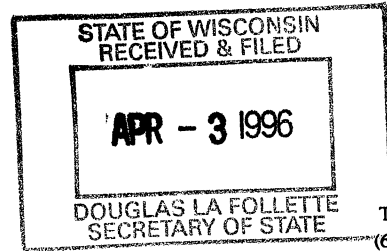

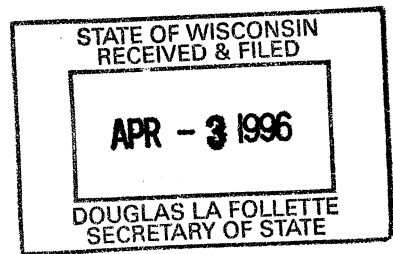

ORDINANCE NUMBER 311

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF ELROY, WISCONSIN.

WHEREAS, a petition for annexation of certain contiguous territory has been filed with the Clerk of this City and with the Clerk of the Town of Plymouth in which the territory proposed to be annexed is located; and

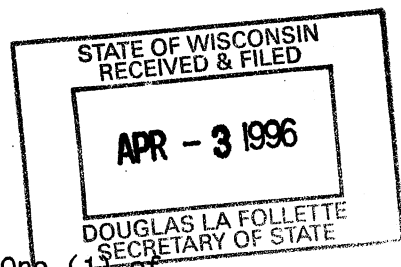
WHEREAS, no electors reside in the territory proposed to be annexed, the population is zero, and the owner of all the real property in such territory has signed said petition; and

WHEREAS, all the requirements of Wisconsin Statutes 66.021(12) appear to have been complied with; THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Elroy does ordain as follows:

1. It is in the best interest of the public and of the City that the lands described in the petition for annexation be included in the limits of the City.

2. Pursuant to the Wisconsin Statutes 66.021, the corporate limits of the City of Elroy, Wisconsin, are extended to enclose the following described territory:

The Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE1/4 SE1/4) of Section Twenty (20), Township Fifteen (15) North, Range Two (2) East, EXCEPTING THEREFROM the following described parcel of land, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the north line of said SE1/4 of the SE1/4 fifty (50) feet west of the northeast corner thereof; thence west to the center line of the new channel of the Baraboo River; thence southerly and easterly along the center line of the present channel of said river to a point about 726 feet south of the point of beginning; thence north to the point of beginning and FURTHER EXCEPTING lands at Volume 342 of Records at Page 31 which were formerly lands deeded to the railroad for right-of-way and excepting lands deeded for highway purposes.



3. The lands described herein shall be annexed to Ward One (1) of the City of Elroy and shall be in part of the City School District and subject to the laws governing the same.

4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
