AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF MERRILL, WISCONSIN, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 66.025 OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES

The Common Council of the City of Merrill, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

#### Section 1. Territory Annexed.

In accordance with Section 66.025, Wisconsin Statutes, and the petition for direct annexation filed with the City Clerk, the following described territory in the Town of Pine River, Lincoln County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the City of Merrill, Wisconsin.

Annexing the following described territory from the Town of Pine River, Lincoln County, Wisconsin, to the City of Merrill, Wisconsin.

A part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE1/4 SE1/4) of Section Seven (7) and a part of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW1/4 SW1/4) of Section Eight (8) all in Township Thirty-one (31) North, Range Seven (7) East, Lincoln County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the southeast corner of Section Seven (7), Township Thirty-one (31) North, Range Seven (7) East, and thence proceeding north O degrees 4' 5" East 100 feet to a point, being the point of beginning; thence continuing north O degrees 4' 5" East along the centerline of Pine Ridge Road, a distance of 185 feet to a point; thence north 89 degrees 54' west a distance of 33 feet to a point being also the southeast corner of Parcel No. 1 of Certified Survey Map No. 141, recorded in Volume 1 Certified Survey Map at page 158, Lincoln County Registry of Deeds; thence westerly to the southwest corner of said Parcel No. 1 of said Certified Survey Map No. 141; thence northerly to the southeast corner of Parcel No. 3 of Certified Survey Map No. 205 recorded in Volume 1 of Certified Survey Records on page 247, Lincoln County Registry of Deeds; thence westerly to the southwest corner of said Parcel No. 3 of Certified Survey Map No. 205; thence northerly to the northwest corner of Parcel No. 1, Certified Survey Map No. 141, recorded in Volume 1, Certified Surveys on page 158; thence easterly to the northeast corner of said Parcel No. 1 in Certified Survey Map No. 141 recorded in Volume 1, Certified Surveys on page 158, being also the western right-of-way line of Pine Ridge Road; thence continuing north 89 degrees 54' East a distance of 33 feet to a point on the centerline of Pine Ridge Road being also the east line of the southeast quarter of Section Seven (7), Township Thirty-one (31) North, Range Seven (7) East; thence

North O degrees 4' 5" East a distance of 770.48 feet to a rebar on said east line; thence south 89 degrees 59' 15" East a distance of 1,231.45 feet to a rebar; thence south O degrees 44" 53' West, 96.27 feet to a rebar; thence south 18 degrees 43" 25' West, 1,190.51 feet along the westerly right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 51 to a rebar; thence south 89 degrees 54" 10' West, 849.49 feet along the north right-of-way line of State Trunk Highway 64 to the point of beginning.

#### Section 2. Effect of Annexation.

From and after the date of this ordinance the territory described in Section 1 above, shall be a part of the City of Merrill for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City governing wards.

#### Section 3. Aldermanic Designation.

The territory described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made part of the Eighth Aldermanic District of the City of Merrill subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City governing wards.

#### Section 4. Schools.

The territory described in Section 1 is annexed for school purposes and for school equalization to the Merrill Area Common Public School District and subject to all laws governing the same.

#### Section 5. Zoning.

The territory described in Section 1 above, is hereby temporarily zoned as part of the Thoroughfare Commercial development of the City.

#### Section 6. Severability.

If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid unconstitutional provisions or application.

#### Section 7. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
