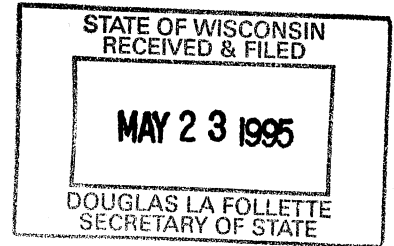

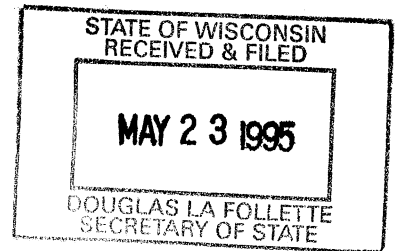

AN ORDINANCE

The Common Council of the City of Merrill, Wisconsin, does ordain
as follows:

Section 1. Territory annexed.

Annexing the following described property from the Town of
Pine River, Lincoln County, Wisconsin to the City of
Merrill, Wisconsin:

Part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$
SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 7, Township 31 North, Range 7 East, Town of
Pine River, Lincoln County, Wisconsin, more particularly de-
scribed as follows: Commencing at the Southeast corner of
said Section 7; thence N 0 deg 04' 05" E, along the center-
line of Pine Ridge Avenue, being also the East line of said
Section 7, 100.25 feet, being also the point of real begin-
ning; thence S 89 deg 54' W, 33.00 feet to the intersection
of the Westerly right-of-way of Pine Ridge Avenue and the
Northerly right-of-way of S.T.H. 64 thence continuing South
89 deg 54' W along said Northerly right-of-way of S.T.H. 64,
275.00 feet; thence N 0 deg 04' 05" E, 185 feet; thence S 89
deg 54' W 308 feet; thence S 0 deg 04' 05" W along the
centerline of Pine Ridge Avenue to the point of real begin-
ning.

Section 2. Condition and effect of annexation.

From and after the date of publication of this ordinance,
the territory described in Section 1 above shall be part of
the City of Merrill for any and all purposes provided by law
and all persons coming or residing within such territory
shall be subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of
the City governing wards. This annexation is contingent on
the property annexed to the City maintaining the same number
and locations of driveways as is currently existing as of
the date of annexation.

Section 3. Aldermanic designation.

The territory described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the Eighth Aldermanic District of the City of Merrill subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City governing wards.

Section 4. Schools.

The territory described in Section 1 is annexed for school purposes and for school legalization to the Merrill Area Common Public School District and subject to all laws governing the same.

Section 5. Zoning.

The territory described in Section 1 is hereby temporarily zoned thoroughfare commercial.

Section 6. Severability. In the event any section, subsection, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance. It is the legislative intent of the Common Council that this ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal provision had not been included or any illegal application had not been made.

Section 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.

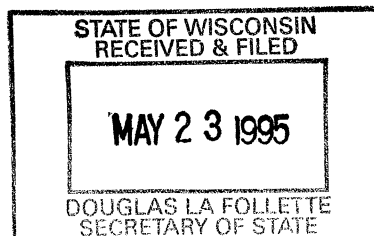

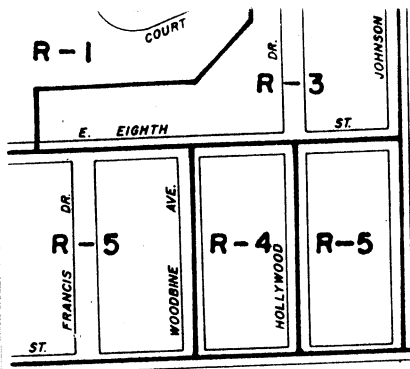
