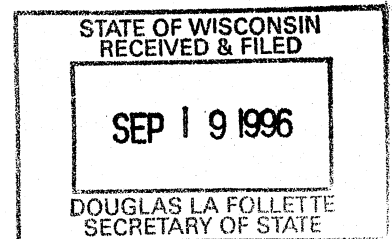

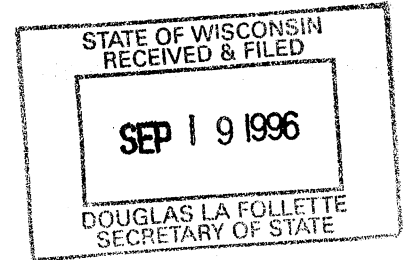



## AN ORDINANCE

The Common Council of the City of Merrill, Wisconsin, does ordain  
as follows:

### Section 1. Territory annexed.

Annexing the following described property from the Town of  
Pine River, Lincoln County, Wisconsin to the City of  
Merrill, Wisconsin:

Part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE  
 $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE  $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section Seven (7), Township Thirty-one (31) North,  
Range Seven (7) East, Town of Pine River, Lincoln County,  
Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:  
Commencing at the Southeast corner of said section 7; thence  
N.  $0^{\circ} 04' 05''$  E, 555.25 feet; thence S  $89^{\circ} 54'$  W, 33.00 feet  
to the point of real beginning; thence N  $0^{\circ} 04' 05''$  E,  
769.35 feet; thence S  $88^{\circ} 42' 15''$  W, 596.55 feet; thence S  
 $2^{\circ} 39' 50''$  W, 757.78 feet; thence N  $89^{\circ} 54'$  E, 630.70 feet  
to the said point of real beginning. Also known as Parcels  
4 and 5 of Certified Survey Map No. 205 recorded in Volume 1  
of Certified Surveys on page 247 as Document No. 248386,  
Lincoln County Registry.

AND:

The South 33 feet of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast  
Quarter (NE  $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE  $\frac{1}{4}$ ), EXCEPT the West 669 Feet thereof,  
Section Seven (7), Township Thirty-one (31) North, Range  
Seven (7) East, Town of Pine River, Lincoln County,  
Wisconsin.

Section 2.      Condition and effect of annexation.

From and after the date of publication of this ordinance, the territory described in Section 1 above shall be part of the City of Merrill for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City governing wards. This annexation is contingent on dedication to the City of Merrill of the north 66 feet of the property being annexed for the purpose of the extension of Thielman Street to Pine Ridge Avenue.

Section 3.      Aldermanic designation.

The territory described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the Eighth Aldermanic District of the City of Merrill subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City governing wards.

Section 4.      Schools.

The territory described in Section 1 is annexed for school purposes and for school equalization to the Merrill Area Common Public School District and subject to all laws governing the same.

Section 5.      Zoning.

The territory described in Section 1 is hereby temporarily zoned thoroughfare commercial.

Section 6.      Severability. In the event any section, subsection, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance. It is the legislative intent of the Common Council that this ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal provision had not been included or any illegal application had not been made.



Section 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.



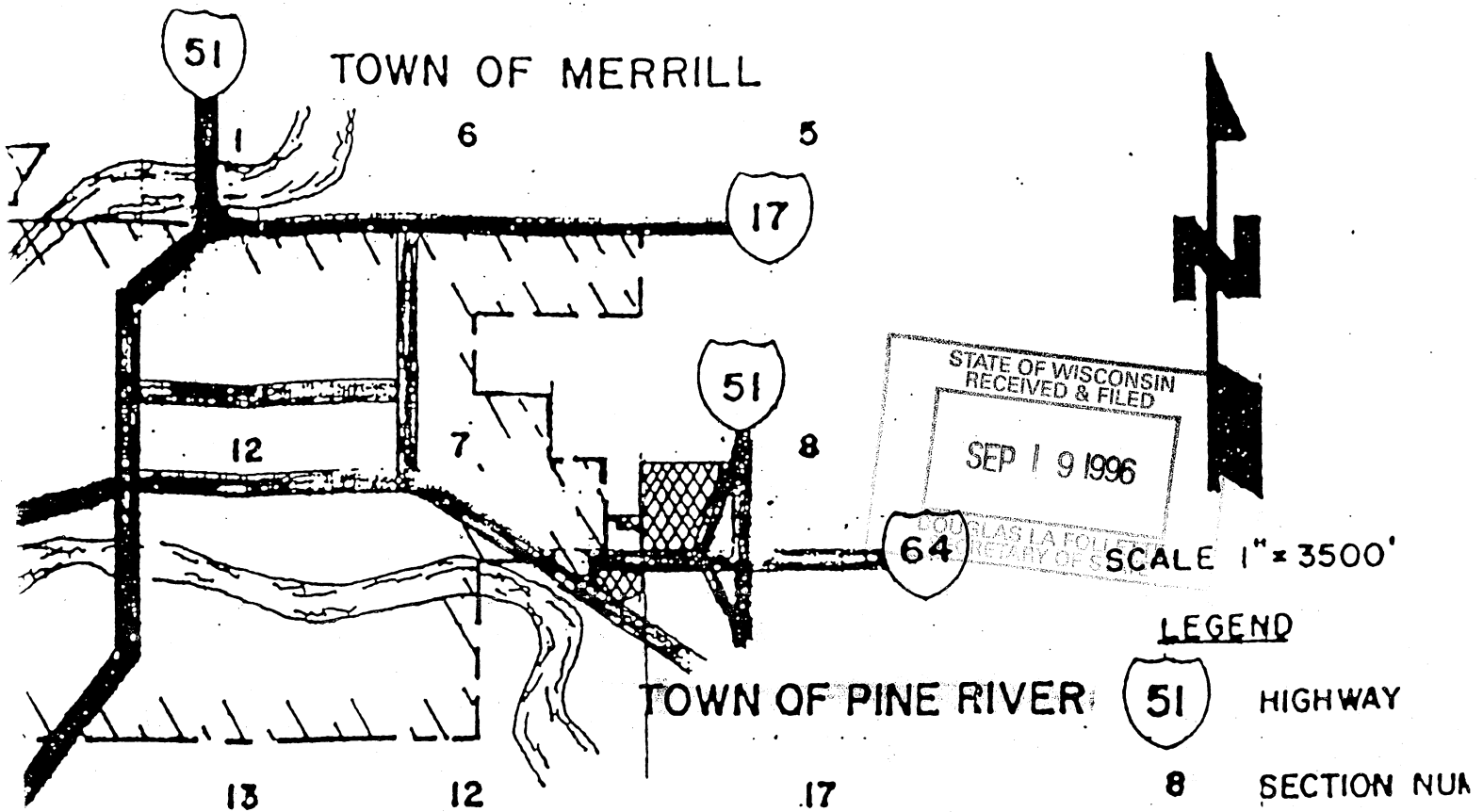
