A CHARTER ORDINANCE AMENDING CLVIL SERVICE ORDINANCE NO. 251 PROVIDING FOR PLACING SCHOOL BOARD AND VOCATIONAL AND ADULT SCHOOL BOARD EMPLOYEES UNDER CIVIL SERVICE.

The Common Council of the City of Cudshy do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The Civil Service Ordinance No. 251 is hereby amended as follows:

Page 3, caption "CLASSIFICATION", originally reads as follows:

"CLASSIFICATION:

- 1. All offices and positions in the public service in said City shall be divided into two classes, mamely the classified and the unclassified service shall include:
 - (a) All officials elected by the people.
 - (b) All members of boards or commissions.
 - (c) The officers, servants and employees of the School Board.
 - (d) The officers, servants and employees of the Fire and Police Commission.
 - (e) Inspectors, clerks and ballot clerks of election as provided by law.
 - (f) Health Commissioner.
 - (g) Assessor.
- 2. All other offices and positions, however, created or filled, shall be included in the classified service, except that this shall have no application to made work or work created for relief purposes, the distribution of which later there shall be upon a fair, equitable and just basis.
- 3. No person shall hereafter be appointed or promoted to, reduced in, transferred to or in or removed from the classified service except in accordance with these enactments."

SECTION 2. Section "(c)" of said paragraph is hereby stricken and said subjection is hereby smended to read as follows:

"(c) Teachers and other employees required to have teaching qualifications for appointment."

SECTION 3. After Paragraph "2" under captioned "CLASSIF-ICATION", there is hereby added the following, to be known as paragraph "2a", to-wit:

"2a. All employees of the School Board and of the Vocational and Adult School Board, excepting teachers and other employees required to have teaching qualifications, shall be selected according to Civil Service requirements. This shall not be construed to divest the School Board of any authority to control such employees after appointment or of any authority to establish positions, compensation, hours or other conditions of employment. The sole authority to discharge or discipline employees shall continue to be vested in the School Board and Board of Vocational and Adult Education.

SECTION 4. Said Ordinance No. 251 shall remain in full force and effect, except as hereinabove amended.

CHARTER ORDINANCE: This is a Charter Ordinance and original Civil Service Ordinance and shall take effect sixty days after its passage and publication, unleds within such sixty days a referendum petition shall be filed, as provided by Section 66.01 of the Wisconsin States, in which event this ordinance shall not take effect until submitted to a referendum and approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.
