CERTIFICATE DESCRIBING TERRITORY ATTACHED BY THE
CITY OF CUDAHY, MILWAUKEE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, FROM
THE TOWN OF LAKE AND DESCRIBING THE BOUNDARIES OF
THE CITY OF CUDAHY AFTER ANNEXATION PURSUANT TO
SECTION 62.07 (3) OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES

I, the City Clerk of the City of Cudahy, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, certify that the following is a description of the territory detached from the Town of Lake by Ordinance No. 386 passed by the Common Council of the City of Cudahy on September 16, 1952,

By Ordinance No. 386:

"All that part of the North East One-quarter (N.E. 1/4), North West One-quarter (N. W. 1/4), South West One-quarter (S.W. 1/4), and South East One-quarter (S. E. 1/4) of Section numbered Twenty-seven (27); the North West One-quarter (N. W. 1/4), South West One-quarter (S. W. 1/4), South East One-quarter (S. E. 1/4) and North East One-quarter (N. E. 1/4) of Section numbered Thirty-four (34); and the South West One-quarter (S. W. 1/4) and North West One-quarter (N. W. 1/4) of Section numbered Thirty-five (35), all in Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East, in the Town of Lake, County of Milwaukee, State of Wisconsin, bounded and described as follows; to-wit:

"Commencing at a point in the present limits line of the City of Cudahy, said point being One Hundred Eighty (180) feet South of the Northeast corner of the North East One-quarter (N. E. 1/4) of Section numbered Twenty-seven (27), Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East; running thence West on a line One Hundred Eighty (180) feet South of and parallel to the North line of the North East One-quarter (N. E. 1/4) and the North West One-quarter (N. W. 1/4) of Section numbered Twenty-seven (27), Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East, to a point in the Westerly Right-of-Way line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad; thence Southerly and following along the Westerly Right-of-Way line of said Railroad to a point in the South line of the South West One-quarter (S. W. 1/4) of Section numbered Thirty-four (34), Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East, said point being in the center line of E. College Avenue; thence East along the South line of the South West One-quarter (S. W. 1/4) and South East One-quarter (S. E. 1/4) of Section numbered Thirty-four (34) and the South line of the South West One-quarter (S. W. 1/4) of Section numbered Thirty-five (35), all in Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East, to a point in the present limits line of the City of Cudahy; thence Northerly and following along the present limits line of the City of Cudahy to the point of commencement."

And that the following is a description of the boundary of the City of Cudahy, after alteration by said Annexation:

"Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Southwest One-quarter (SW 1/4) of Section numbered Twenty-three (23), Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East; thence Easterly on and along the North lines of these following one-quarter sections: The Southwest One-quarter (SW 1/4) of

Section numbered Twenty-three (23), Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East; the Southeast One-quarter (SE 1/4) of Section numbered Twenty-three (23), Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East, and the Southwest fractional One-quarter (SW fractional 1/4) of Section numbered Twenty-four (24), Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East, to the waters edge of Lake Michigan thence Southerly on and along the shore of said Lake Michigan, approximately two and one-half (2 1/2) miles to the intersection of the South line of the Southwest fractional One-quarter (SW fractional 1/4) of section numbered Thirty-six (36), Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East, thence Westerly on and along the South lines of these following One-quarter Sections: The Southwest fractional One-quarter (SW fractional 1/4) of Section numbered Thirty-six (36) Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East; the Southeast One-quarter (SE 1/4) of Section numbered Thirty-five (35), Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East; the Southwest One-quarter (SW 1/4) of Section numbered Thirty-five (35), Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East; the Southeast One-quarter (SE 1/4) of Section numbered Thirty-four (34), Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East; and that part of the Southwest One-quarter (SW 1/4) of Section numbered Thirty-four (34), Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East, to a point in the Westerly right-of-way line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad; thence Northerly on and along the Westerly right-of-way line of said Railroad approximately two (2) miles to a point, said point being One hundred eighty (180) feet South of the North line of the Northwest One-quarter (NW 1/4) of Section numbered Twenty-seven (27), Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East, thence East on a line One Hundred Eighty (180) feet South of and parallel to the North line of the Northwest One-quarter (NE 1/4) and the Northeast One-quarter (NE 1/4) of Section numbered Twenty-seven (27) and the Township numbered Six (6) North Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East, to the intersection of the West line of the Northwest One-quarter (NW 1/4) of Section numbered Twenty-six (26), Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East; thence Northerly on and along the West line of these following One-quarter Sections: the Northwest One-quarter (NW 1/4) of Section numbered Twenty-six (26), Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East, and the Southwest One-quarter (SW 1/4) of Section numbered Twenty-three (23), Township numbered Six (6) North, Range numbered Twenty-two (22) East, to the point of beginning of this description; said land being in the County of Milwaukee, State of Wisconsin."

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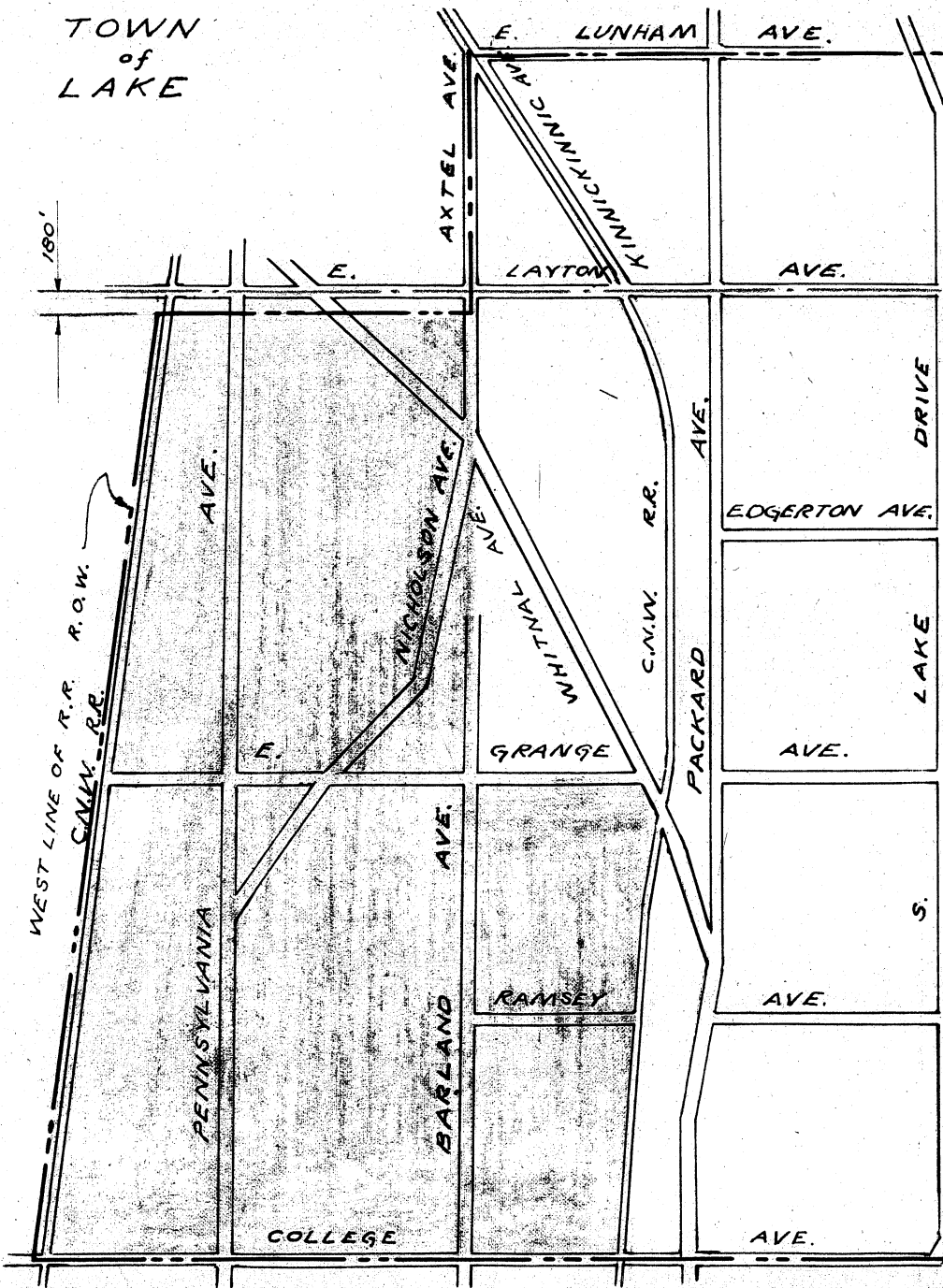
