AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF CLINTONVILLE FROM THE TOWN OF LARRABEE, WAUPACA COUNTY, WISCONSIN

Section One: <u>Territory Annexed</u>. Pursuant to the authority granted by Section 66.021(12), Wis. Stats., and the Petition for Direct Annexation filed with the City Clerk-Treasurer on the 5th day of May, 1983, signed by the owner of all of the real property in the territory proposed for annexation, there being no electors residing therein, the following described territory in the Town of Larrabee, Waupaca County, Wisconsin, is hereby annexed to the City of Clintonville:

Part of the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 35-25-14, bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the intersection of the center line of the New London-Shawano Road (now known as Highway 22 and 45) with the North line of said Section 35, running thence South 10 degrees 29 minutes West along the center of the highway 209.14 feet, thence South 89 degrees 54 minutes East 226.46 feet, thence North 7 minutes East 209.73 feet to the North line of the aforesaid Section 35, thence West on the Section line 195 feet to the place of beginning.

Section Two: Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance, the territory described in Section One shall be a part of the City of Clintonville for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within said territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Clintonville.

Section Three: <u>Temporary Zoning Classification</u>.

(a) Upon recommendation of the Plan Commission, the territory annexed to the City of Clintonville by this ordinance is temporarily designated to be part of the following district of the City for zoning purposes and subject to all provisions of the

Clintonville Municipal Code relating to such district classification and to zoning:

Class B-1, General Commerical District.

(b) The Plan Commission is directed to prepare an amendment to the applicable portion of the Clintonville Zoning Ordinance setting forth a permanent classification and regulations for the zoning of the annexed area and to submit its recommendations to the Common Council not later than May 1 , 1984.

Section Four: <u>Ward Designation</u>. The territory described in Section One of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the Fourth Ward, Third Aldermanic District of the City of Clintonville, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City of Clintonville governing wards and districts.

Section Five: <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be effected without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section Six: Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
