AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF EAU CLAIRE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAU CLAIRE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with Section 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the following described territory in the Town of Hallie, Chippewa County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the city of Eau Claire, Wisconsin.

That part of the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 28, T 28 N, R 9 W, Town of Hallie, Chippewa County, Wisconsin, described as follows:

Lot 1 of Chippewa County CSM Map No. 219 contained in Vol. 1, pp. 289, 290, Chippewa County CSM, except that portion now described as Chippewa County CSM Map No. 224 contained in Vol. 1, pp. 295, 296, Chippewa County CSM.

Section 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance, the territory described in Section 1 shall be part of the city of Eau Claire for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the city of Eau Claire.

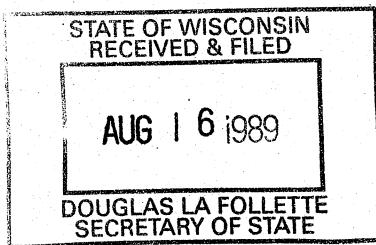
Section 3. Temporary Zoning Classification. The territory annexed to the city of Eau Claire by this ordinance is temporarily designated to be R-1A -- 1-Family Dwelling District (Large Lots) for zoning purposes and subject to all provisions of the zoning ordinance of the city of Eau Claire relating to such district classification and to zoning in the city.

Section 4. Ward Designation. The territory described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the 16th Ward

and the 1st District of the city of Eau Claire, subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations of the city governing wards and districts.

Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or application of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or applications.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

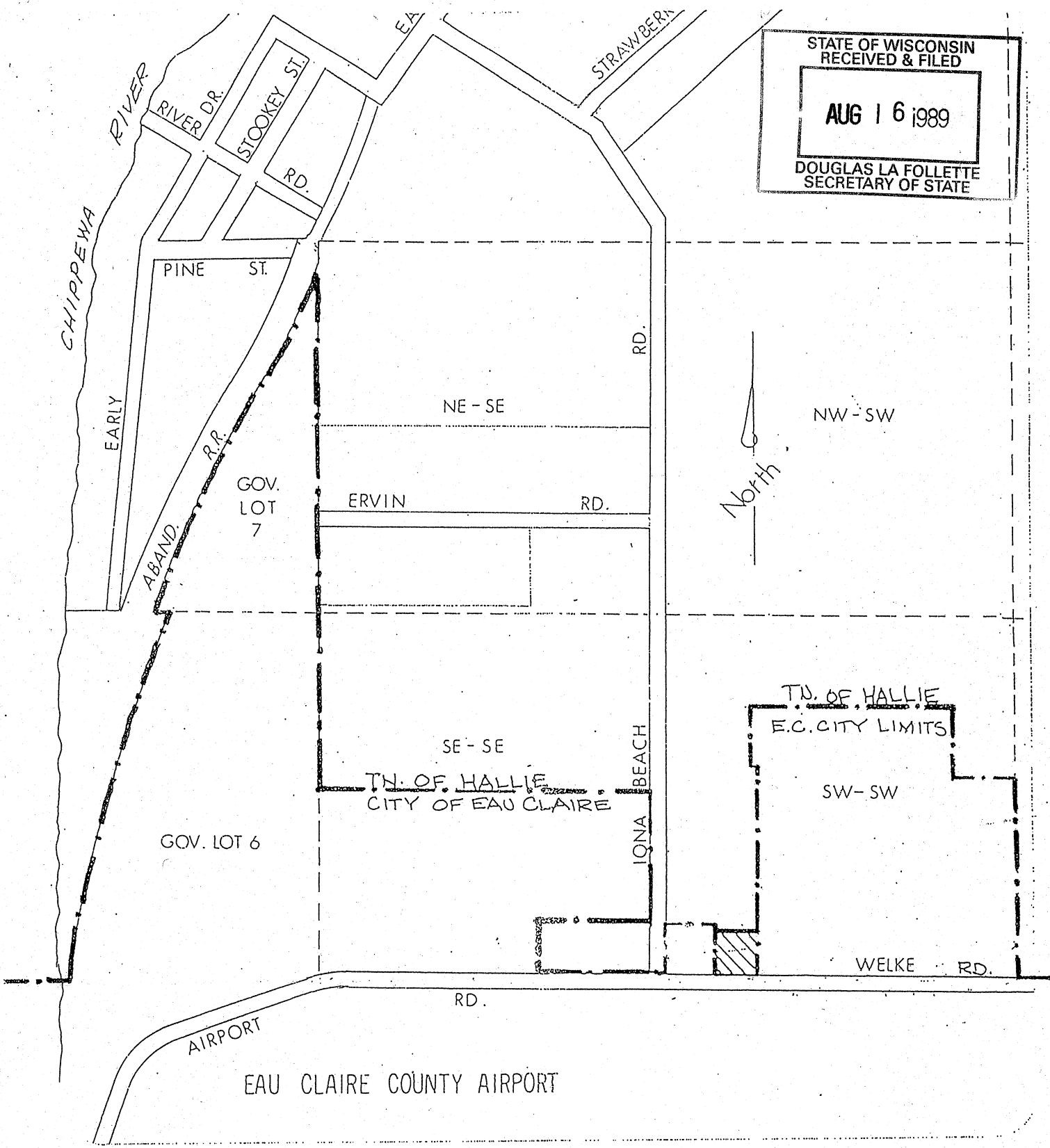


