Section 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with Section 66.021

of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1979, the following described territory in the Town of Harrison, Outagamie County, Wisconsin lying contiguous to the City of Appleton is hereby annexed to the City of Appleton, Wisconsin.

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The West one-half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of the East one-half ($E\frac{1}{2}$), of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Five (5), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Eighteen (18) East, Town of Harrison, Calumet County, Wisconsin.

Section 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this Ordinance the territory described in Section 1 shall be a part of the City of Appleton for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all Ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Appleton.

Section 3. Ward Designation. The territory described in Section 1 of this Ordinance is hereby made a part of the Twenty-third Ward of the City of Appleton, subject to the Ordinances, rules and regulations of the City governing wards.

Section 4. Schools. The territory described in Section 1 is annexed for school purposes and is hereby made a part of the City School District and subject to all the laws governing the same.


Section 5. Zoning. The territory described in Section 1 is hereby zoned as follows: R-1A One Family Residential District.



invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.


