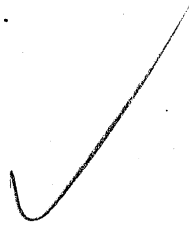

A CHARTER ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OSHKOSH REGULATING AND ESTABLISHING THE TERMS OF OFFICE OF TREASURER AND OFFICE OF COMPTROLLER IN THE CITY OF OSHKOSH, AND THE MANNER OF CHOOSING SUCH OFFICERS.

The Common Council of the City of Oshkosh, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 62.09 (3) (b) 6 of the Wisconsin Statutes for 1945, is hereby repealed in so far as it affects the terms of office and manner of choosing the City Treasurer and City Comptroller of the City of Oshkosh, Wisconsin.

SECTION 2. Commencing on the 1st day of May 1947, and continuing thereafter until changed by the Common Council, pursuant to the statutes in such case made and provided, the City Treasurer and City Comptroller of the City of Oshkosh shall be chosen by appointment by the Council and after such appointment shall hold office until removed in accordance with Section 17.12 (1) (c) (d) of the Wisconsin Statutes for 1945.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as provided by law, and particularly as provided by 66.01 of the Wisconsin Statutes for 1945.
