



AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF HARTFORD  
 WISCONSIN (Alton Greget, Raymond Margelowsky, John Martin,  
 Hubert Doll, Michael Raasch and Esther Carey  
 Properties) and establishing zoning classifications

The Common Council of the City of Hartford, Washington/Dodge  
 Counties, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. TERRITORY ANNEXED. In accordance with Section 66.021  
 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the following described territory located in  
 the Town of Hartford, Washington County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the City  
 of Hartford, Wisconsin.

That portion of the the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 20, T10N,  
 R18E, Washington County, Wisconsin, described as follows:


Commencing at the west one-quarter corner of said Section 20, thence  
 N 89o 56' 42" E, along the one-quarter section line, 661.54'; thence  
 N 0o 10' 07" E, along a property line, 314.46' to the point of  
 beginning; thence N 0o 10' 07" E, along a property line and across  
 STH "60", 371.6' to the northerly right-of-way line of said STH "60";  
 thence N 58o 32' 10" W, along said northerly right-of-way line,  
 149.17'; thence N 15o 51' 49" E, along a property line, 176.03';  
 thence N 88o 25' 34" E, along a property line, 80'; thence S 0o 11'  
 41" W, along a property line, 88'; thence S 58o 32' 10" E, along a  
 property line, 254.70'; thence south, along a property line, 158.9'  
 to the north line of said STH "60"; thence S 58o 32' 10" E, along  
 said north line 90.4'; thence S 2o 59' W, along a property line,  
 257.1'; thence N 77o 30' W, 289.5' along a property line, to the  
 point of beginning. Containing 3.43 acres more or less. Population:  
 19.


SECTION 2. EFFECT OF ANNEXATION. From and after the date and  
 filing of this ordinance, the territory described in Section 1 shall be a  
 part of the City of Hartford for any and all purposes provided by law and  
 all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to  
 all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Hartford.


SECTION 3. ZONING CLASSIFICATION. The Raasch property shall be  
 zoned Rd-1 duplex, and the remaining properties therein shall be zoned  
 single-family as follows: Margelowsky, Rs-2; Martin, Rs-3; Doll,  
 Rs-2; Carey, Rs-2; Greget, Rs-3.

SECTION 4. ALDERMANIC DISTRICT DESIGNATION. The territory  
 described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the  
 First and Second Aldermanic Districts of the City of Hartford, subject  
 to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City governing  
 aldermanic districts.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect upon  
 passage and publication as provided by law.
