I, I. A. Smits, Clerk of the City of De Pere, Wisconsin, hereby certify that on the 9th day of April, 1956, the following described property was annexed to the City of De Pere from the Town of Lawrence:

"The most Easterly 670 feet of Lot 125, Assessor's Subdivision West side of Fox River, formerly in the City of De Pere, now in the Town of Lawrence, and being laid off on fractional Section 21, Township 23 North, of Range 20 East."

I further certify that on the 10th day of July, 1956, the following described property was annexed to the City of De Pere from the Town of De Pere:


"Commencing at the point of intersection of the North line of Private Claim Thirty Seven (37), East Side of Fox River, being also the present Southerly line of the City of De Pere, with the easterly line of Highway 57, and running thence Southerly along the easterly line of said Highway to the intersection of the South line of said Private Claim Thirty Seven (37); thence South Sixty Four (64) Degrees East along the South line of said Private Claim Thirty Seven (37) to the Westerly line of the right-of-way of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railway Company; Thence Northerly along the West line of said right-of-way to the North line of said Private Claim Thirty-Seven (37), East Side Of Fox River; and thence North Sixty-Four (64) Degrees West, along the North line of said Private Claim Thirty-Seven (37) to the place of beginning."

I further certify that on the 14th day of August, 1956, the following described property was annexed to the City of De Pere from the Town of Lawrence:

"The following parcels all located in the Town of Lawrence and described by reference to Assessor's Subdivision of lands in the City of Nicolet, now West De Pere, Wisconsin (Volume 1 of Plats, page 153, Brown County, Wisconsin records):

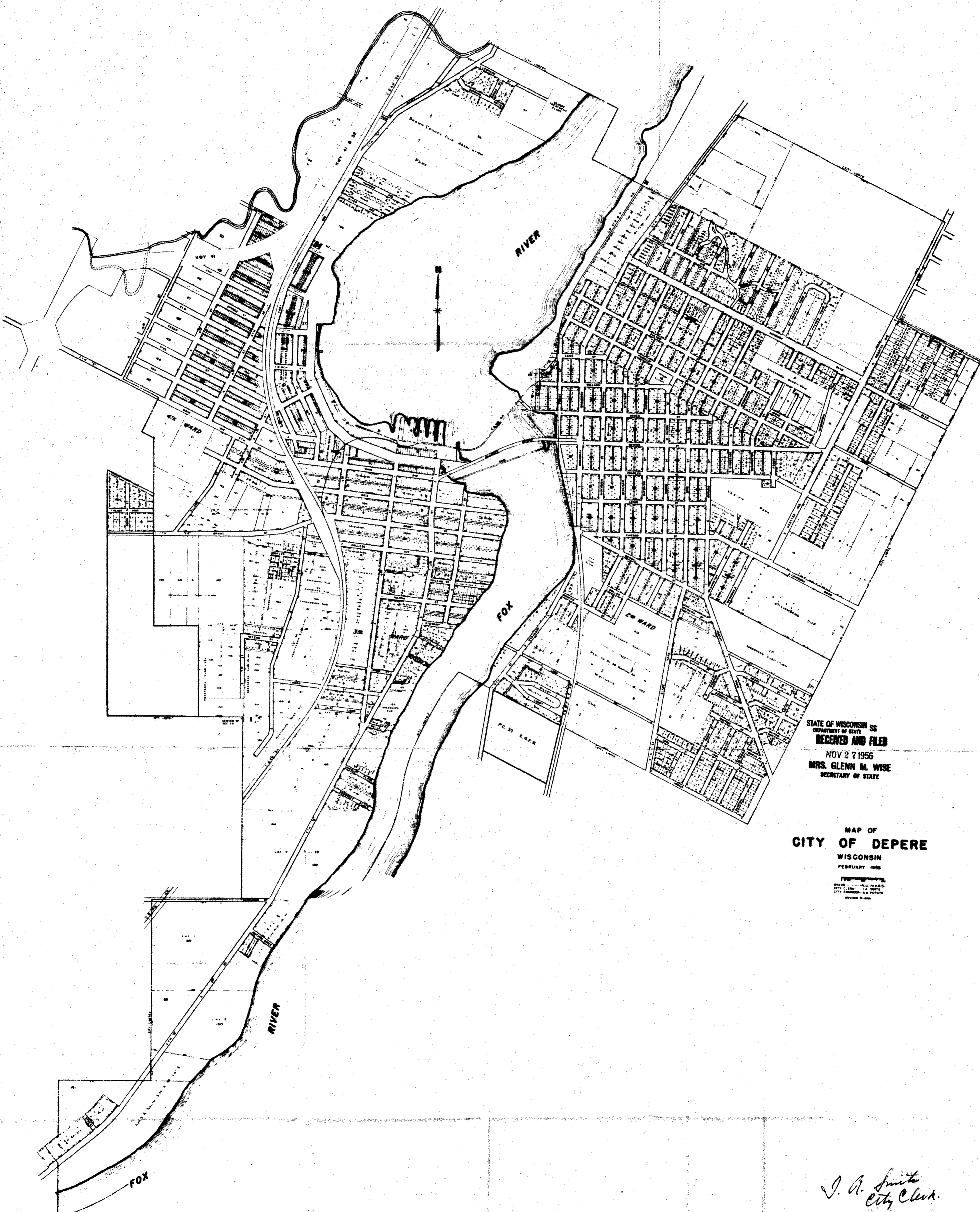
- Parcel #1: Lot Number One Hundred Thirty Seven (137) except part conveyed for highway purposes;
- Parcel #2: Lot One Hundred Thirty Eight (138), except part conveyed for highway purposes;
- Parcel #3: Lot Number One Hundred Fifty and one half (150½).

CITY BOUNDARIES

The district of country in the county of Brown contained within the following boundaries, shall be a city by the name of De Pere to wit: Commencing at the middle of the Channel of Fox River where the north line of private claim number twenty-nine, on the East Side of Fox River, intersects, or if extended would intersect said channel, running thence easterly along said north line of private claim number twenty-nine, on the East Side of Fox River, to the center line of North Broadway (Riverside Drive); thence northerly along the center line of North Broadway (Riverside Drive) sixteen hundred and seventeen and $7/100$ feet, thence easterly one hundred five feet, thence southerly fifty and $8/100$ feet, thence easterly along a line fifty feet south of the north line of private claim number twenty-seven, on the East Side of Fox River, to the center line of Webster Avenue, thence southerly along the center of Webster Avenue to the north line of private claim number twenty-nine, thence easterly along said north line of private claim number twenty-nine to a point eighty-three rods beyond its crossing of Webster Avenue, running thence in a straight line at right angles to said claim^{LINE} to the south line of private claim number thirty-six, on the East Side of Fox River, running thence westerly along the said south line of said claim number thirty-six to the center line of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad right of way, southerly said center line of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific right of way to the south line of private claim number thirty-seven, thence westerly along said South line of private^{LINE} number thirty-seven to the center line of South Broadway, northerly along said center line of South Broadway to the south line of private claim number thirty-six, thence westerly along said south line of private claim number thirty-six to the center of the Channel of Fox River aforesaid, and running thence in a southerly direction along the middle of the channel of said river to a point where a line extending easterly from the southern point of lot number three in section thirty-three, town twenty-three north, range twenty east and parallel to the southern boundary line of said section, intersects the middle thread of Fox River; thence westerly to the western boundary line of said lot three, thence northerly to the center line of Third Street, thence northwesterly along the southern bounday of Lot Two, Rivervista Plat, to the western boundary of said lot two, thence northerly along the western boundary of said lot two to the northern boundary of said lot two, thence southeasterly along the northern boundary of said lot two, Rivervista Plat, to the western boundary line of lot three in section thirty-three, town twenty-three north, range twenty east, thence northerly to the northwest corner of said^{LINE} three thence easterly along the northern boundary of said lot three to the western boundary of lot two in said section, thence northerly along the western boundary of lots one and two in said section thirty-three to the northern boundary of said section, thence easterly along said northern boundary to the western boundary of lot number five, in section twenty-eight, in said town and range. Thence northerly along the western boundary of lots number four and five, in section twenty-eight, to the center point of said section twenty-eight; thence westerly along the quarter section line of section twenty-eight to the southwest corner of lot number 137 Assessor's Subdivision, West Side of Fox River; thence northerly along the westerly line of lot number 137 and the Krutz Plat to the center line of Morning Glory Lane thence southeasterly along the center line of Morning Glory Lane to the western boundary of lot 109 Assessor's Subdivision, West Side of Fox River; thence northerly along the westerly line of lot number 109 extended to its intersection with the southerly line of Lot C Assessor's Subdivision of 1925 of the north $3/7$ (three sevenths) of private claim 29; thence northwesterly along the southerly line of said Lot C to the southwest corner of said lot C; thence northeasterly along the westerly line of said lot C to the center line of Main Avenue; thence westerly along the center line of Main Avenue to its intersection with the center line of North Tenth Street; thence northeasterly along the center line of North Tenth Street to the center of Ashwaubenon Creek; thence northerly along the center of said Creek down stream to the point where the center channel line of said Ashwaubenon Creek intersects the north line of lot C Assessor's Subdivision of 1925 of the north $1/4$ (one fourth) of private claim number 26 extended; thence easterly along the northerly line of said lot C extended, to the middle^{LINE} of the Fox River; thence southerly along the said middle line of the Fox River to the place of beginning, shall comprise the territory and limits of the City of De Pere.
